

- 2. Female sex organ; birth canal
- **5.** The first two months of development in the uterus
- **7.** Doctor who specializes in the female reproductive system
- **9.** Doctor who specializes in the male reproductive system and the urinary tract
- **10.** Female sex cell produced in the ovaries
- **13.** Male sex cell produced in the testicles
- **15.** Tube responsible for bringing urine (and semen) out of the body
- 16. A hormone produced in the ovaries
- **18.** Hold the fetus during pregnancy; the womb
- 19. Folds of skin outside the vagina

- **20.** When the penis becomes engorged with blood and becomes hard
- **21.** The last 7 months of development in the uterus
- **23.** Organ that produces sperm and hormones
- **25.** Male hormone produced in the testicles
- **26.** When semen leaves the penis through the urethra

<u>Down</u>

- 1. Organ that nourishes the fetus during development
- **3.** Gland that produces a chemical fluid to protect the sperm
- **4.** Stores sperm cells until they reach maturity
- **6.** Entrance to the uterus; dilates 10 cm during labor

- **8.** The uterus begins to squeeze the fetus out of the body
- **11.** Glands that produce egg cells and hormones
- **12.** Period during which adolescents reach sexual maturity and become capable of reproduction
- 14. When a sperm cell joins an egg cell
- **17.** Discharge of blood from the uterus, also known as a period
- 22. Fluid ejaculated from the penis
- **24.** Sac that hold the testicles and regulates temperature
