

2. The Crown attorney has the right to proceed summarily, and impose a less severe punishment, or to proceed by indictment

 Not criminal or occurs when death is caused by accident or self-defence
Also called mercy killing; one person acts to end another life

**12.** Means to help someone commit a crime

**16.** Guilty mind

**18.** This document is signed by the accused who promises to appear in court on a certain date

**19.** The maximum penalty under the criminal code is 20,000 and/or six months in jail

**20.** To perform an action means that the intent is limited to the act itself and the person has no other criminal purpose in mind

**21.** "I didn't want him to steal my laptop, so I hit him on the head with my bag. I have a right to protect my property!"

**22.** Granted anytime, a duration of 5 to 15 days

**1.** A court order requiring a person to keep the peace and behave well for a specific period of time

 Planned and deliberate murder of a police officer or prison guard while on duty
Requirements for legally binding agreements

**6.** A sentence in which the offender must meet certain expectations in order to avoid a record and a new sentence

**7.** A penalty ordering imprisonment for a period that is not fixed

**9.** When a youth has been found guilty of an offence, but no convictions are recorded, and the youth is free to go without conditions

**10.** Repeatedly displays behaviour that could cause death, injury, or psychological harm

**11.** Assignment for offender as he was deemed dangerous and likely to escape **13.** Something given to make amends for a loss

**17.** A sentence that allows the offender provisional freedom rather than imprisonment
