

- 3. knotted strings used by Inca officials for record-keeping
- 4. culture that thrived in the Andean region from about 400 BC to 600 AD
- 7. culture thrived in a region from about 200AD-1000, developed on shores of lake Titicaca in modern day Bolivia, reigned over parts modern-day of Argentina, Chile, and Peru.
- 8. culture that thrived in Andean region from about 600 AD- 1000, controlled much of Peru's mountain and costal areas.

- 12. culture that thrived in Andean region from 200 BC. to ad 600
