

- **2.** Unlawful entry into a building with the intent to commit a crime
- 3. Intentional act by person creating apprehension/fear in another. Threat to commit bodily harm, destroy property, blackmail, or any other action the person receiving the threat would consider harmful.
- 7. The taking of property from Uber site, employee, person doing business at Uber, accompanied by force (assault, push, struggle) or fear (threat of harm, show of weapon)
- 9. training event
- **12.** Person standing around or walking idly without apparent business at Uber facility, to include person found sleeping at facilities
- **14.** Intentional act of damaging the property (facilities, equipment)
- 17. When a piece of equipment critical to performance of duties malfunctions, including body camera, radio, vehicle, D3 mobile device, and site cell phone

- **18.** An Uber employee, contractor, or any person doing business at Uber who becomes injured or ill
- **19.** Unexpected visit by regulatory agency for purpose of requesting (or seizing) equipment, network access, employee information, or shutting down business operation.
- **20.** Any item that could be used as a container (box, backpack, briefcase, etc) and has been left unattended or abandoned

Down

- Loud verbal dispute causing an officer to intervene, provide command presence or record (body cameras) the incident. Physical altercation includes throwing an object at someone, striking or pushing.
- 4. Facility operation or maintenance need
- **5.** Employee requesting general assistance with business-related operations (direction, resources, IT, HR, etc)
- **6.** Includes trespassing, evidence of tampering, but not a break-in

- 8. Person behaves in a way causing one to think he/she is questionable, dishonest, or dangerous. Their actions are not in line with normal actions/behaviors of others given the same situation.
- **10.** Any event that Uber has a presence, such as a planned sporting event, concert, political event, rider lounge and Event Security needs to be involved
- **11.** Unlawfully seizing or carrying away (moving a person by force or fraud)
- **13.** Threat made by phone, email, regular mail or in-person of a bomb on or near facility(ies)
- **15.** Unsolicited contact or interest in an A-Team member
- **16.** Weather, natural disaster, city-wide power outage, protest, civil disturbance, or public health event impacting (or could impact) travel safety and Uber business operations
