

- 6. WHEN AN INFANT REACTS BY THROWING OUT HIS/ HER ARMS AND LEGS IN RESPONSE TO A LOUD NOISE.
- 7. WHEN SOMETHING IS PUT IN A INFANTS MOUTH, THE BABY BEGINS TO SUCK.
