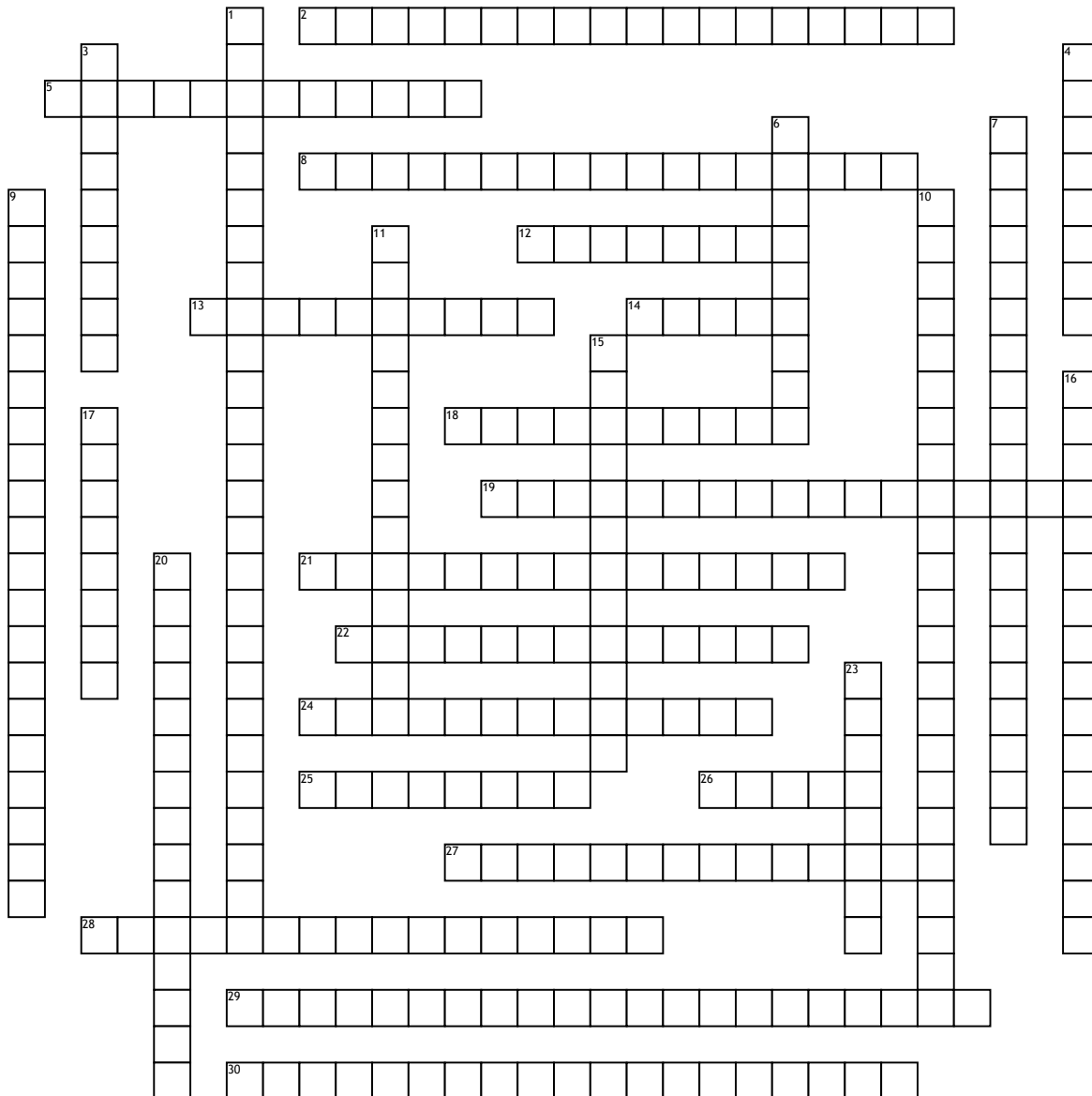


# Infection Control 1

2. barbers itch  
 5. a condition in which the body reacts to injury, irritation, or infection; characterized by redness, heat, pain, and swelling  
 8. disease that is spread from one person to another person  
 12. slender, hair-like extensions used by bacilli and spirilla for locomotion  
 13. capable of destroying fungi  
 14. round shaped bacteria that appear singly or in groups  
 18. caused by or capable of being transmitted by infection  
 19. disease caused by pathogenic microorganisms that enter the body  
 21. removal of blood and all other potentially infectious materials on an item's surface  
 22. division of bacteria cells into two new cells called daughter cells

24. presence, or the reasonably anticipated presence, of blood or other potentially infectious materials on an item's surface  
 25. ability of the body to destroy and resist infection  
 26. single cell organisms that grow in irregular masses  
 27. they breakdown stubborn films and remove the residue of pedicure products  
 28. contact with broken skin, blood, bodily fluid, or other potentially infectious material  
 29. disinfectants that are effective for cleaning blood and bodily fluids  
 30. disease causing microorganisms carried in the body by blood or bodily fluids

 4. one-celled microorganisms that have both plant and animal characteristics

6. bloodborne virus that causes disease and can damage the liver  
 7. transmission of blood or bodily fluids through contact with a contaminated object  
 9. a virus that causes warts in humans  
 10. information compiled by the manufacturer about product safety  
 11. an infection that is confined to a particular part of the body and appears as a lesion containing puss

 17. mechanical process using soap and water to remove all visible dirt and debris
