

## Across

- **5.** a brass musical instrument with a flared bell. oboe, a woodwind instrument with a double-reed mouthpiece, a slender tubular body.
- **6.** either of a pair of small, long-bodied drums typically held between the knees and played with the fingers.
- **7.** a bass instrument of the violin family, held upright on the floor between the legs of the seated player.
- **10.** a musical instrument, roughly triangular in shape, played by plucking with the fingers.
- **14.** in the percussion family,It is a bar of metal.
- **17.** a bass instrument of the oboe family with a double reed.
- **18.** instrument of treble pitch played with a horsehair bow.

- **19.** a large keyboard musical instrument with a wooden case enclosing a soundboard and metal strings.
- **20.** a portable musical instrument with metal reeds blown by bellows, played by means of keys and buttons.

## <u>Down</u>

- **1.** a wind instrument made from a tube with holes along it that are stopped by the fingers or keys.
- **2.** a percussion instrument sounded by being struck with sticks.
- **3.** a percussion instrument, with small metal disks in slots around the edge, played by being shaken or hit with the hand.
- **4.** a small rectangular instrument held against the lips and moved from side to side to produce different notes by blowing or sucking.
- **8.** a member of a family of metal wind instruments with a single-reed mouthpiece.

- **9.** a large brass wind instrument with straight tubing in three sections, notes being made using a forward-pointing slide.
- **11.** a woodwind instrument with a single-reed mouthpiece, a cylindrical tube with a flared end, and holes stopped by keys.
- **12.** a large brass wind instrument of bass pitch with three to six valves.
- **13.** a woodwind instrument with a double-reed mouthpiece, a slender tubular body.
- **15.** a stringed musical instrument with a fretted fingerboard, and six or twelve strings, played by plucking or strumming with the fingers.
- **16.** a stringed musical instrument with a long neck and a round open-backed body, played by plucking.
