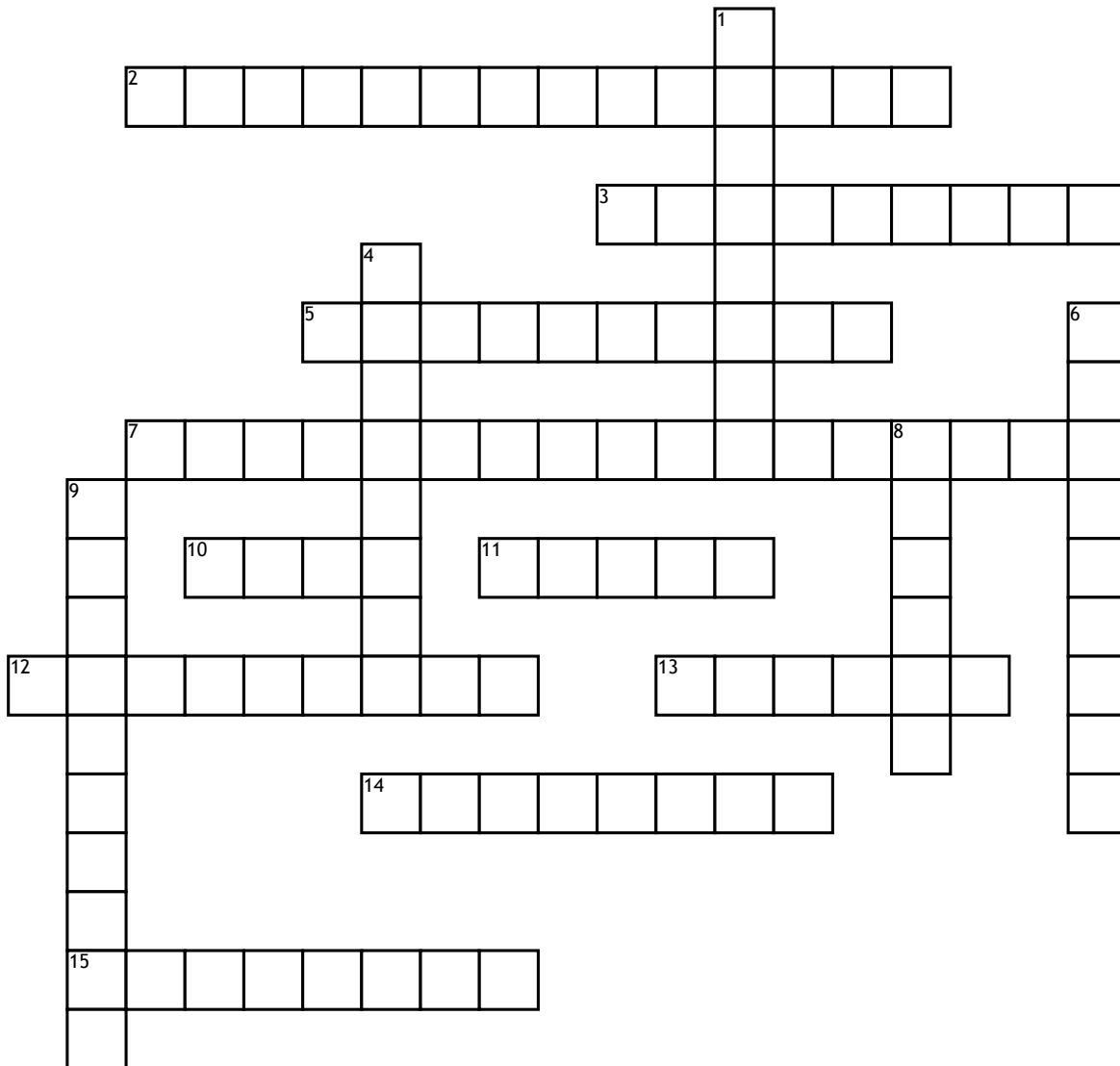

14. The "hole puncher" for colposcopies
