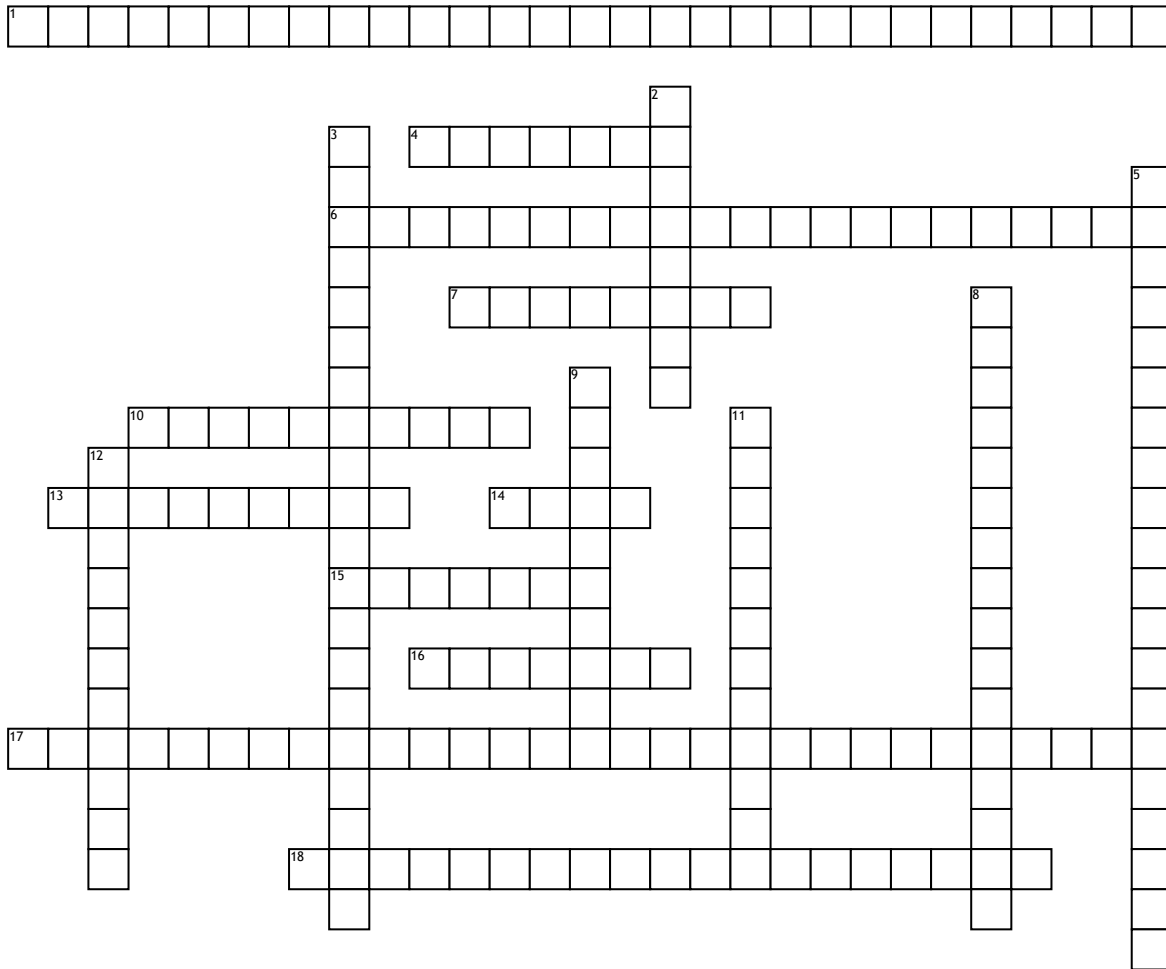

- 13. a designated amount you pay for appointments
