
Insurance Vocabulary

- **4.** Plan with two subgroups, PCP required, in-network, and is typically the cheapest plan option
- 5. plan with no PCP requirement, out-network, and typically the most expensive plan option
- 7. Insurance plan for veterans or family members of veterans
- 13. Children in families who don't qualify for medicaid and can't afford PHI; age limit 18 yrs.
- 14. Fixed amount you pay for a service or medication
- 15. Form provided by the insurance company to the patient explaining what has been paid

- **16.** Federal insurance for qualifying patients above 65 years of age
- 17. Percentage of the cost you pay for a covered service
- 18. insurance for employees injured on the job or at the work-place

- 1. Insurance plan for active military personnel
- 2. Agreement that transfers the insurance claims right or benefits of the policy to a third-party; gives third-party permission to file claims
- 3. medical condition present prior to signing on to a health insurance plan.

- **6.** Authorization required before services are rendered/given, to prove they are medically necessary.
- 8. Determining factor for deciding which plan to charge first, when a dependent is covered by multiple plans
- **9.** insurances pay a fixed amount per patient
- 10. Federal grant insurance to qualifying patients with low income
- 11. Required out of pocket payment before insurance kicks in
- 12. the amount paid to an insurance company
