

- **4.** Is the upper layer of the dermis, it has ridges and valleys causing finger prints.

- **22.** Immune cells live in the skin and provide the first line of defense against infections
- 23. Has two layers, the upper papillary and lower reticular layers
- **24.** Secrete sweat to regulate temperature and are located under the dermis with ducts to the surface
- **25.** The epidermis contains different types of cells, the most common are;

- 1. Living epithelial cells into the dermis that is called the $\,$
- 3. Skin and hair provide protection from harmful ultraviolet
- **5.** These are formed in the bone marrow and then migrate to the epidermis
- 6. Stiffens epidermal tissue to form finger nails

- **7.** its brown or black pigment produced by melanocytes to protect the skin from UV radiation
- **8.** it is primary located beneath the skin, but also found around internal organs.
- 9. It contains connective tissue, blood capillaries, oil and sweat glands, nerve endings, and hair follicles
- 10. Secrete wax to stop dust entering the ear
- 11. When internal temperature rises, the eccrine glands secrete water to the skin surface, where heat is removed by evaporation
- **12.** Shaft projects through the dermis and epidermis and is kept soft by the sebaceous glands
- **14.** The outermost layer of the skin, which is composed of squamous cells
- **20.** The papillary layer is outermost and extends into the epidermis to supply it with vessels
