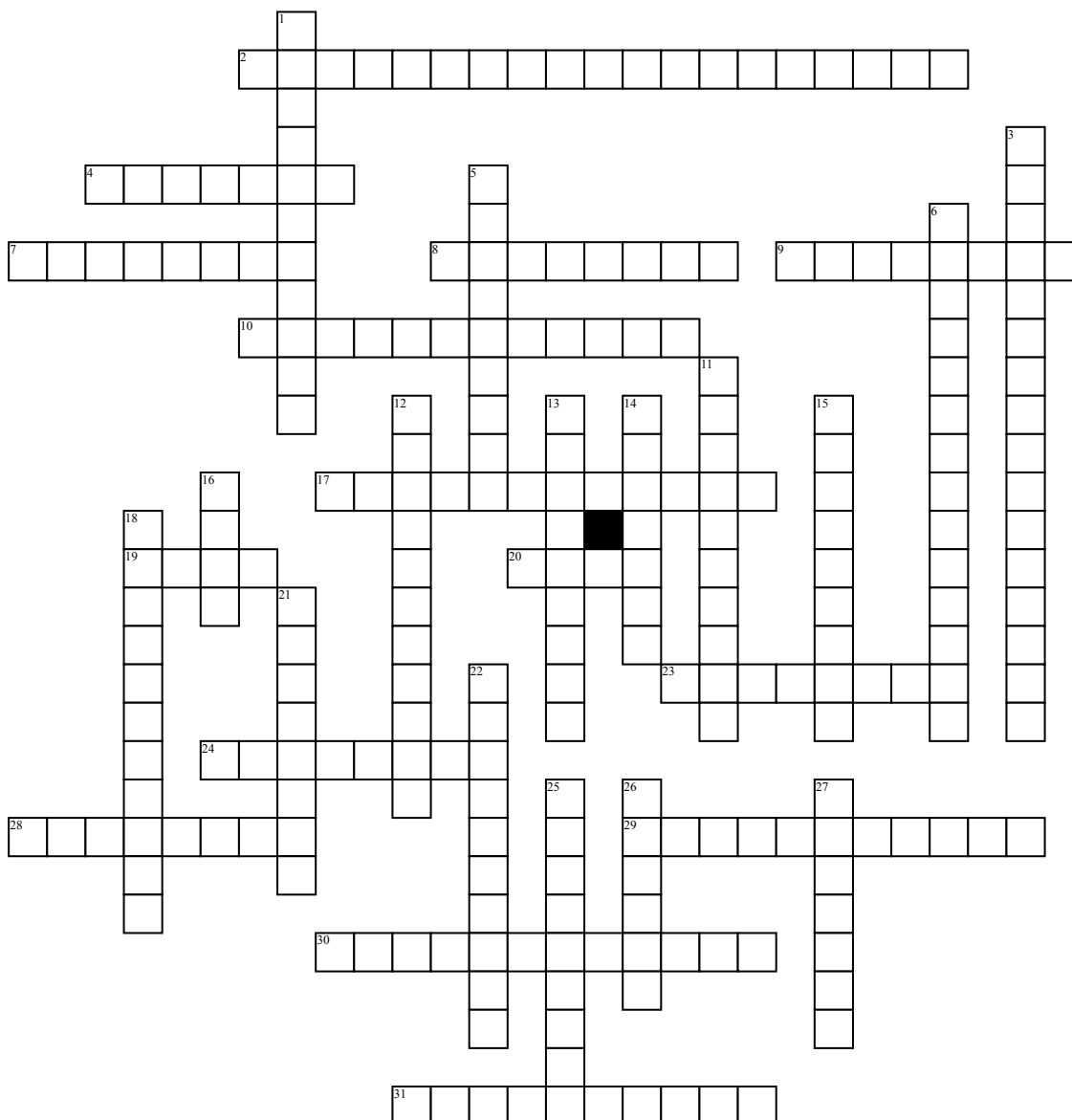

2. infestation with lice on the scalp that causes itching and dermatitis
 4. inflammation of the fingernail or toes
 7. a painful nodule originating deep in a hair follicle often caused by staphylococcus aureus (boils)
 8. Redness of the skin
 9. baldness natural or unnatural deficiency of hair
 10. partial-thickness burn
 17. surgical removal of epidermis frozen by aerosol spray to remove scars tattoos and/or wrinkles
 19. sexually transmitted ulcer-like lesions of the genital and anorectal skin and mucosa
 20. inflammation of sebaceous glands and hair follicles of the skin evidenced by comedones (blackheads) pustules or nodules on the skin

23. a condition in which the pigment is lost due to melanin destruction creating areas of white patches on the skin or hair
 24. tissue death associated with loss of blood supply
 28. severe itching
 29. destruction of tissue by freezing with the application of an extremely cold chemical
 30. whitehead
 31. any disorder of the skin

1. removal of dead tissues from a wound or burn site to promote healing and prevent infection
 3. infestation with the pubic or crab louse
 5. dry skin
 6. loss of melanin pigment in the skin

13. an acute contagious disease caused by chickenpox
 14. a localized collection of pus in a cavity formed by the inflammation of the surrounding tissues

 21. a hereditary condition characterized by a partial or total lack of melanin pigment
