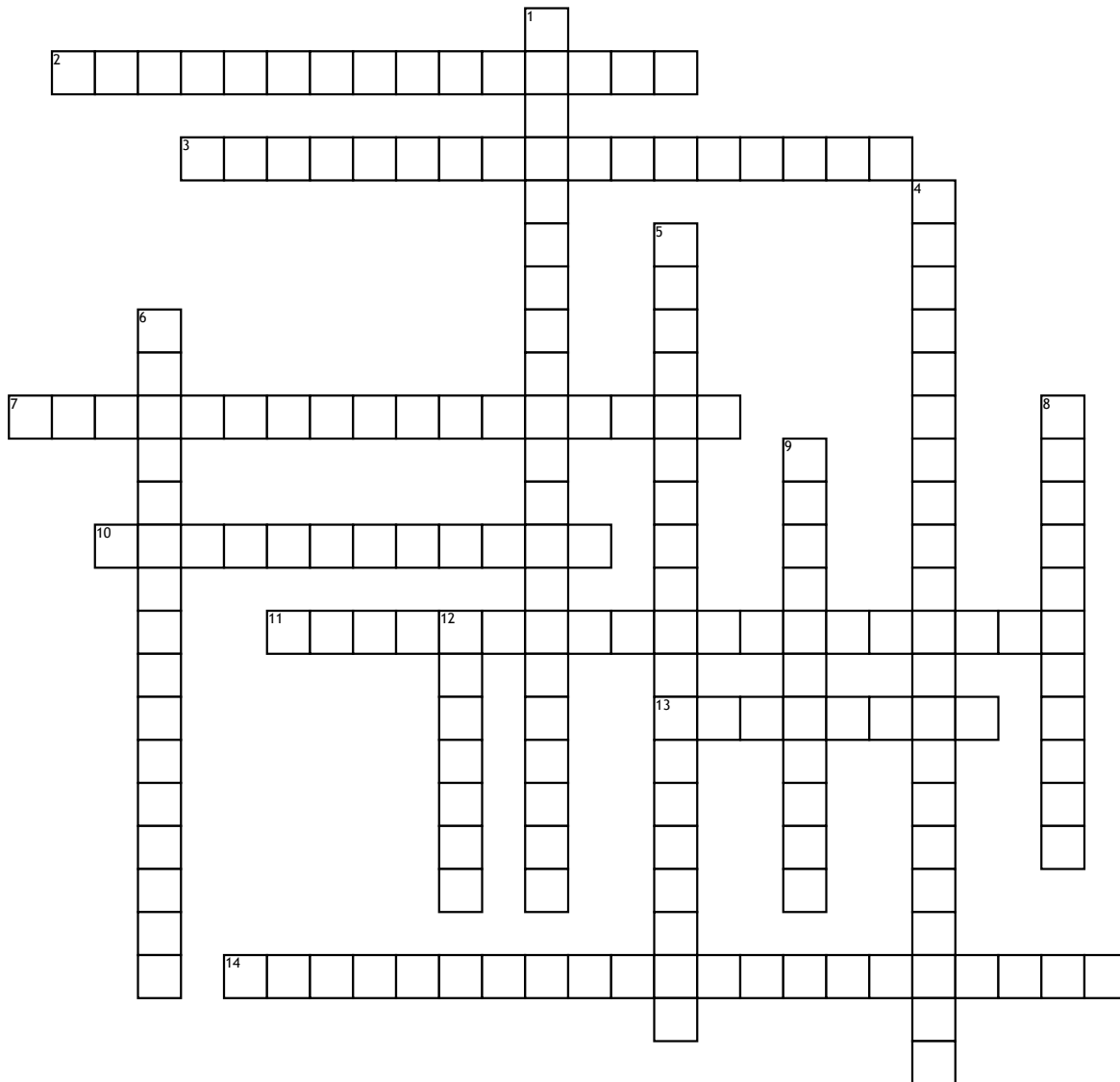

1. measure of the likelihood that the difference between groups results from a real difference between the two groups rather than from chance alone

4. the clues participants discover about the study, including rumors they hear about the study suggesting how they should respond

5. differences between the experimental group and the control group other than those resulting from the independent variable

6. research design in which the participants don't know which treatment group-experimental or control-they are in
