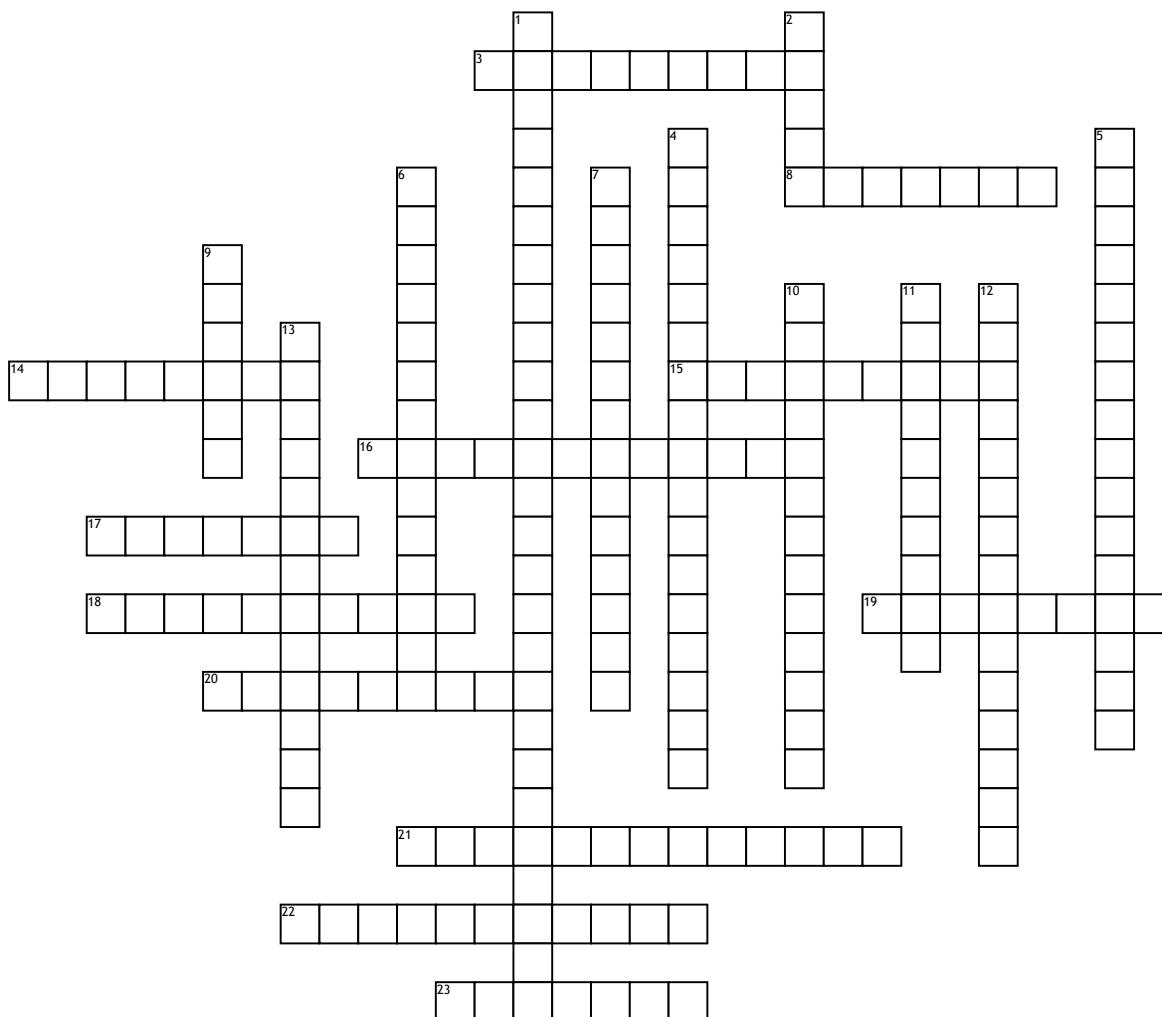

## Across

3. the period in a woman's life (typically between 45 and 50 years of age) when this occurs.

8. a pouch of skin containing the testicles

14. the deliberate termination of a human pregnancy, most often performed during the first 28 weeks of pregnancy.

15. either of the two oval organs that produce sperm in men and other male mammals, enclosed in the scrotum behind the penis.

16. an elastic, muscular canal with a soft, flexible lining that provides lubrication and sensation

17. the small projection in which the mammary ducts of female mammals terminate and from which milk can be secreted.

18. an abnormal absence of menstruation.

19. a test carried out on a sample of cells from the cervix to check for abnormalities that may be indicative of cervical cancer.

20. is defined as the classification of blood based on the presence or absence of inherited antigenic substances on the surface of red blood cells

21. a surgical operation to remove all or part of the prostate gland

22. a birth control (contraceptive) device that prevents sperm from entering the uterus

23. the duct by which urine is conveyed out of the body from the bladder, and which in male vertebrates also conveys semen
