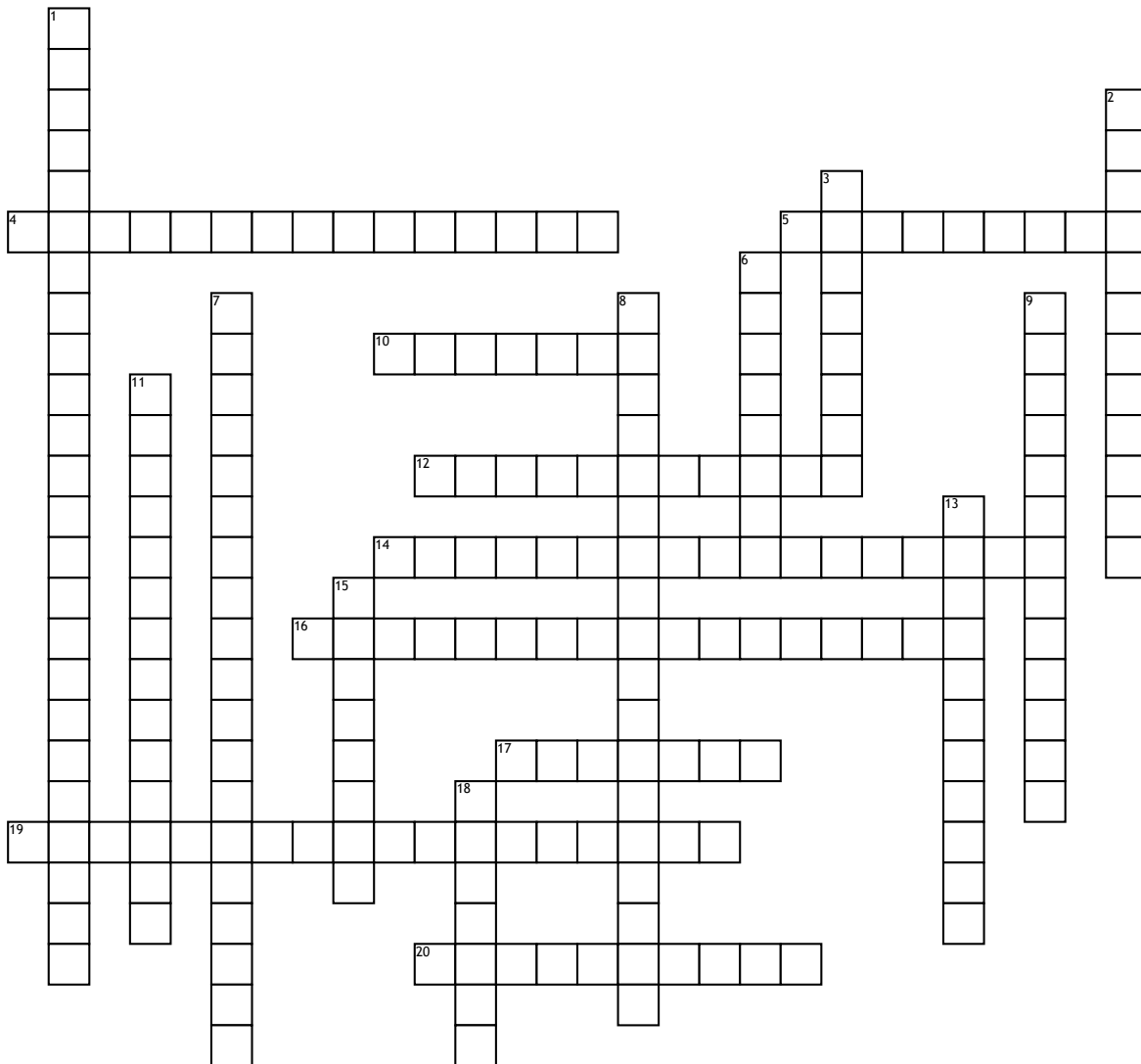


# Jefferson as President
