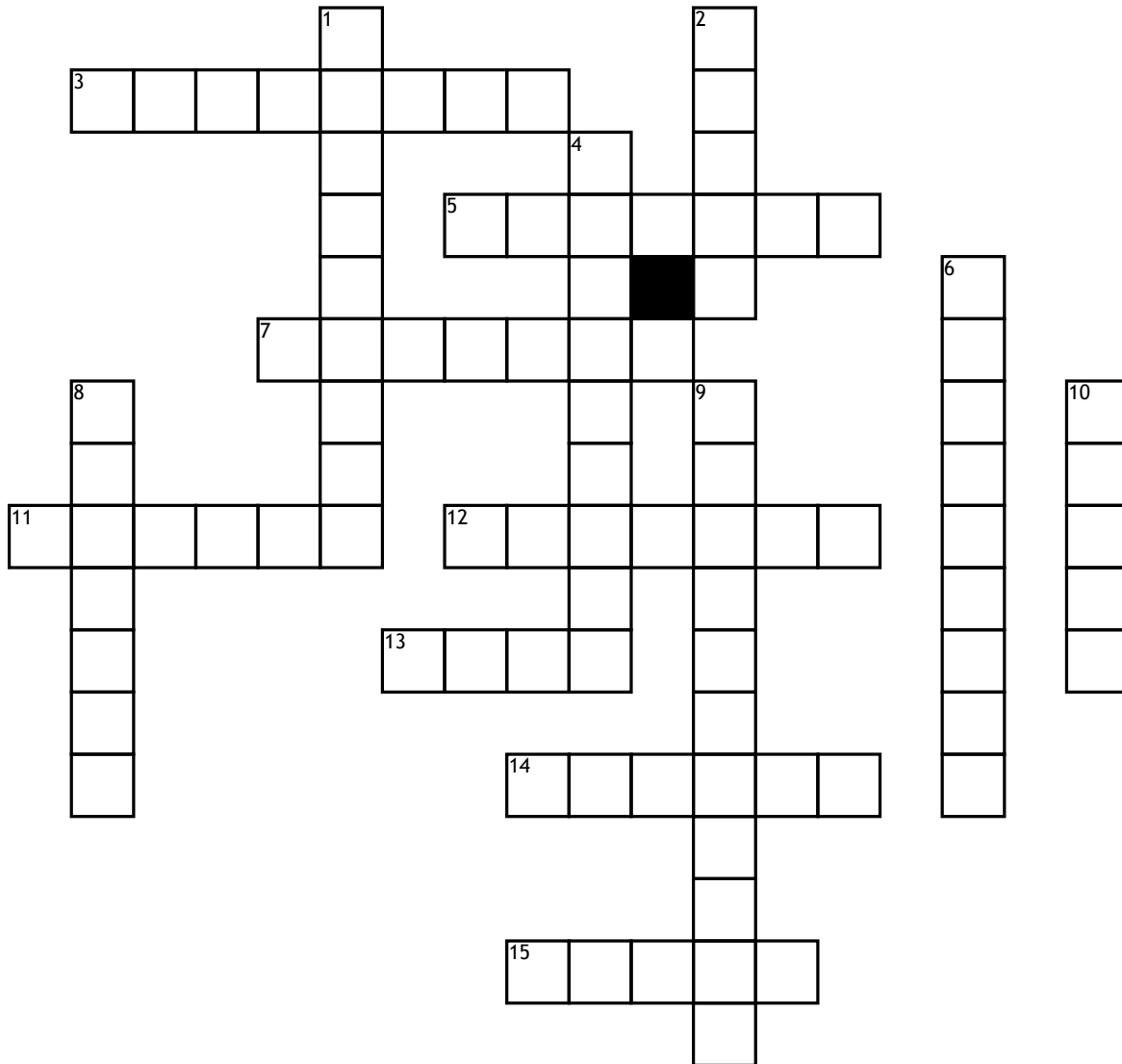


# Joseph in Egypt
