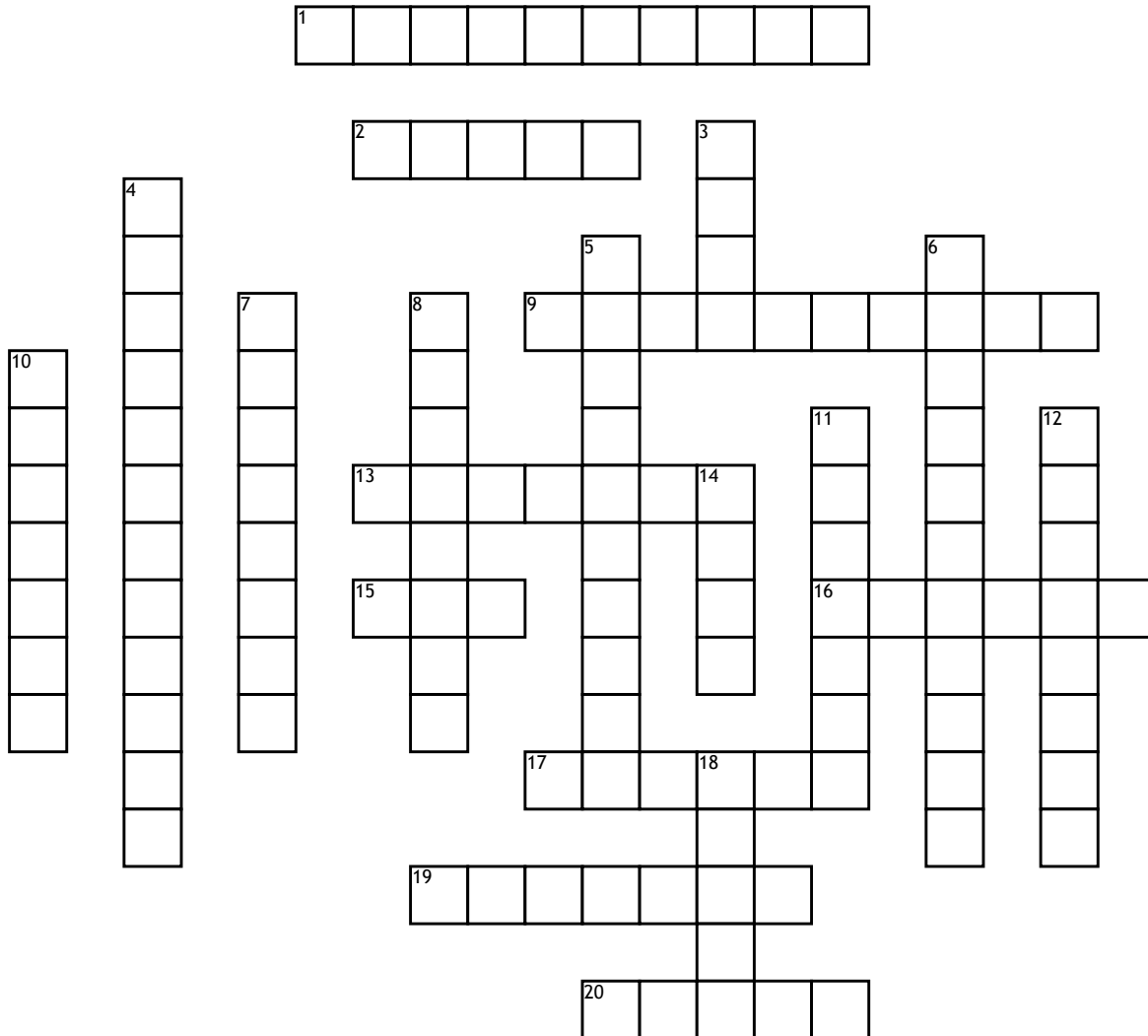


Julius Caesar crossword
