

## <u>Across</u>

8. (1774-1848 CE) a period of significant revolutionary movements in Europe and the Americas
9. murderous phase of the French Revolution from September 1793 until the fall of Robespierre in 1794
10. (1899-1901 CE) Chinese uprising led by peasants known as "Boxers" opposed to foreign influence and the Qing Dynasty

## <u>Down</u>

1. (1759-1842 CE) Chinese trade policy; established in 1759 CE

**2.** (1884 CE) conference held in Berlin, Germany that regulated European colonization and trade in Africa during the New Imperialism period, and coincided with Germany's sudden emergence as an imperial power

**3.** the decisive battle that ended Napoleon Bonaparte's reign as the Emperor of the French in 1815

**4.** European rush to colonize parts of Africa at the end of the 19th Century

**5.** also called Putting-out System, production system widespread in 17th-century western Europe in which merchant-employers "put out" materials to rural producers who usually worked in their homes to convert materials into products; replaced by the Industrial Revolution

6. (1858-1947 CE) rule of the British monarchy in India following the Great Indian Rebellion of 1857
7. wave of panic that swept French peasants at the start of the French Revolution in 1789 CE
