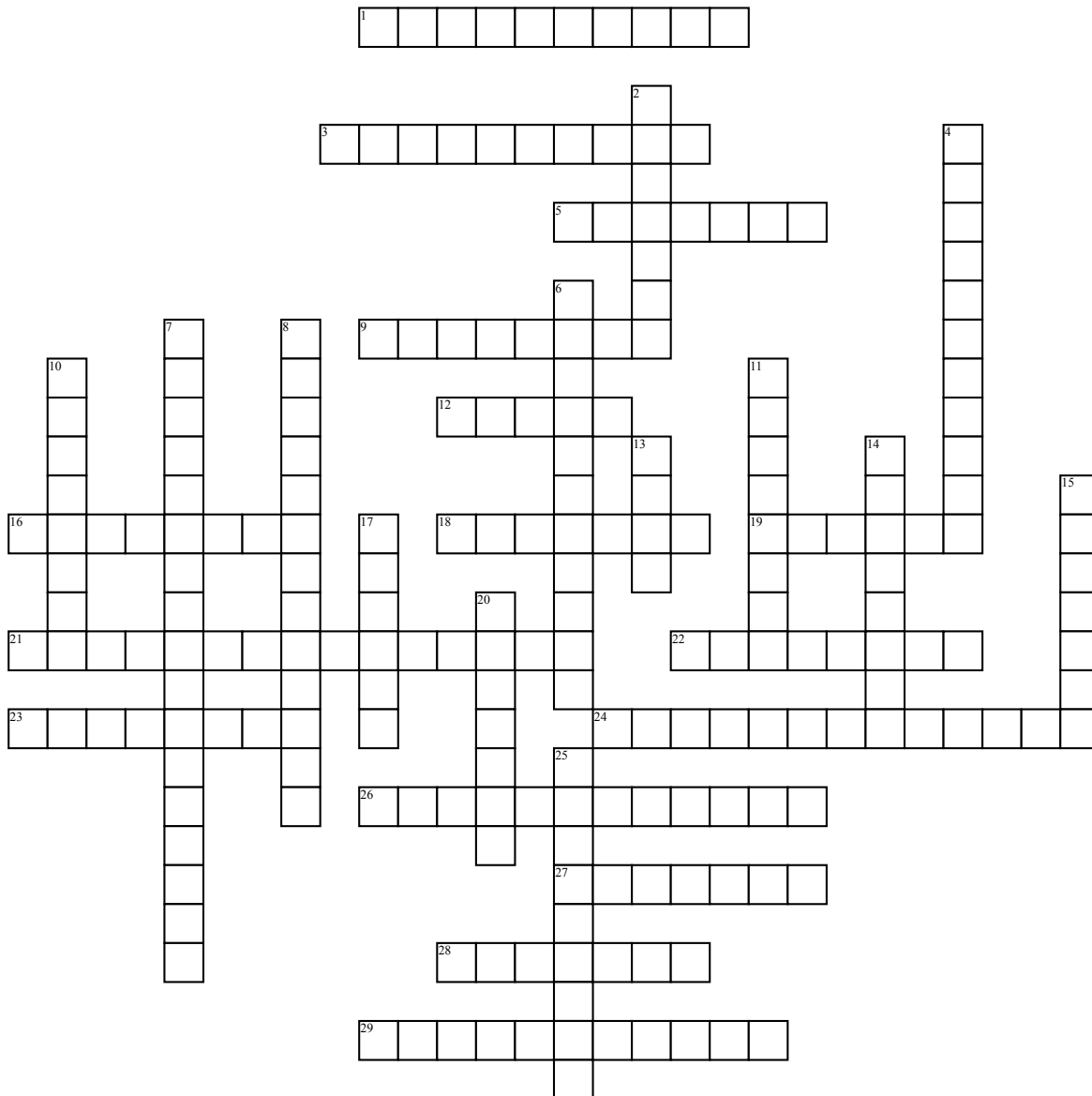


# Key words from questions

1. Provide examples to highlight your thoughts
3. Presenting a "deep" understanding of concepts - quite often a detailed understanding of "how things work and are interrelated"
5. Provide in summary format
9. Select an appropriate factor

16. Show/comment the differences that exist
18. Provide ideas, thoughts and recommendations
19. How one or more factors bring about outcomes and results
21. Description(s) of key features
22. Considering aspects that are directly linked to what is being considered
