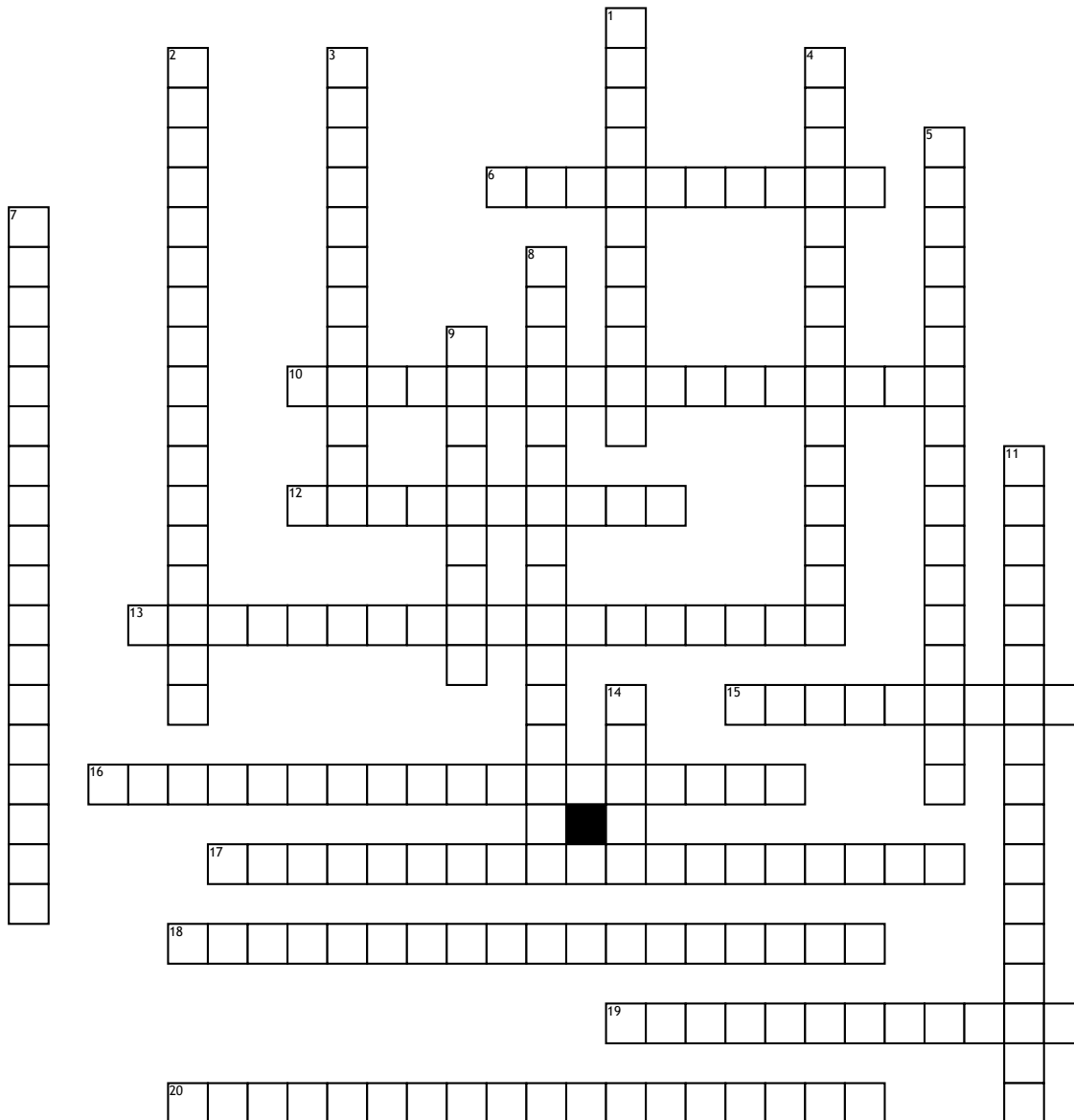

1. an agreement by two or more persons carry on, as co-owners, a business for profit
 2. a partnership that has no duration
 3. one who initiates and assumes the financial risk of a new business enterprise and undertakes to provide or control its management
 4. authorization for another to act as one's agent or attorney either in specified circumstances (special) or in all situations (general)
 5. arises when the principal causes a third party to believe that the agent has authority, even though she or he does not
 7. simplest form of business organization, in which the owner is the business

8. a rule requiring that an agent's authority be in writing if contract to be made on behalf of the principal must be in writing

9. any agreement in which the owner of a trademark, trade name, or copyright licenses another to use that trademark

11. a business entity that has no tax liability

14. relationship between two parties in which the one party agrees to present or act for the other
