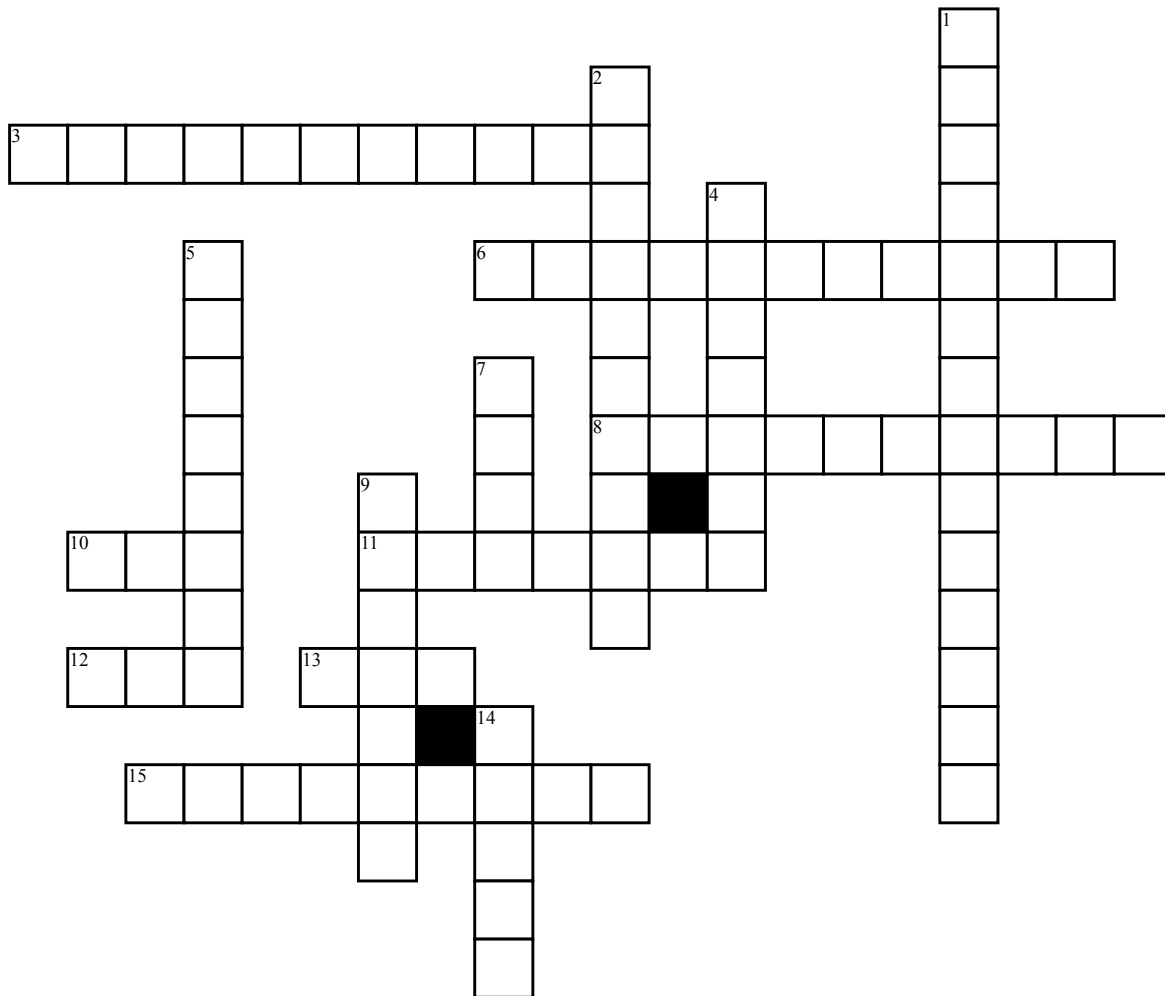

- 3.** Identifies as gender assigned to them at birth.

- 11.** Gender Variance / When a person's behaviour or interests is found outside of what is "normal" for their biological

- 13.** Gender Expression / This term refers to which gender a person prefers to act like. This will be affected by the roles played by each gender in a society and which clothes, and mannerisms are associated with each
