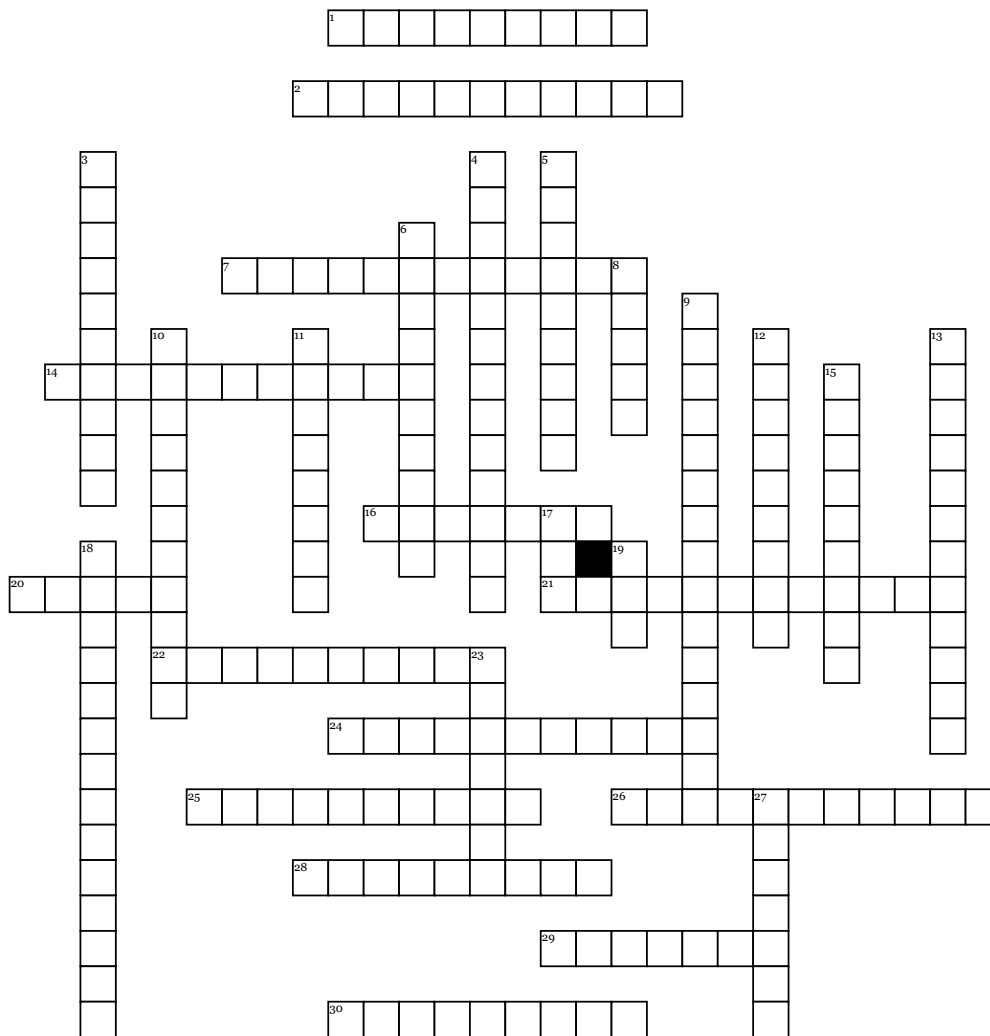

1. Not limited in sexual choice with regard to biological sex, gender, or gender identity
2. Characterized by or involved in the practice of engaging in multiple sexual relationships with the consent of all the people involved.
7. A person who is sexually attracted to people of the opposite sex.
14. Partly male and partly female in appearance; of indeterminate sex.
16. An arch of colours that represents gay pride.
20. An umbrella term for sexual and gender minorities who are not heterosexual and/or not cisgender. Originally meaning "strange" or "peculiar."
21. A person, typically a man, who derives pleasure from dressing in clothes primarily associated with the opposite sex.
22. A person who does not experience sexual attraction unless they form an emotional connection.
24. A person whose sense of personal identity and gender does not correspond with their birth sex.
25. Dislike of or prejudice against homosexual people.

26. The fear of, discrimination against, or hatred of trans people, the trans community, or gender ambiguity.

28. A gender or sexual identity that is not defined in terms of traditional binary oppositions such as male and female or homosexual and heterosexual.

29. Without sexual feelings or associations.

30. Someone who performs femininity theatrically.

3. Romantically attracted to both men and women (typically used with reference to a person who does not experience sexual attraction, or who is sexually attracted to only one gender).

4. Relating to relationships or communication between people.

5. A curiosity about having attraction to people of the same gender/sex.

6. A person sexually attracted to people of one's own sex.

8. Lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, and queer.

9. The condition of feeling one's emotional and psychological identity as male or female to be opposite to one's biological sex.

10. An event that celebrates lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and intersex culture and pride.

11. A person that has both male and female sex organs or other sexual characteristics.

12. Denoting or relating to a person whose sense of personal identity and gender corresponds with their birth sex.

13. Being primarily sexually, romantically and/or emotionally attracted to some genderqueer, transgender, transsexual, and/or non-binary people.

15. Experiencing little or no romantic attraction to others and/or has a lack of interest in romantic relationships/behavior.

17. The opposite of 'In'.

18. A person's perception of having a particular gender, which may or may not correspond with their birth sex.

19. A homosexual (used especially of a man).

23. A homosexual woman.

27. A trans person who is not "out" as trans, and is perceived by others as cisgender.
