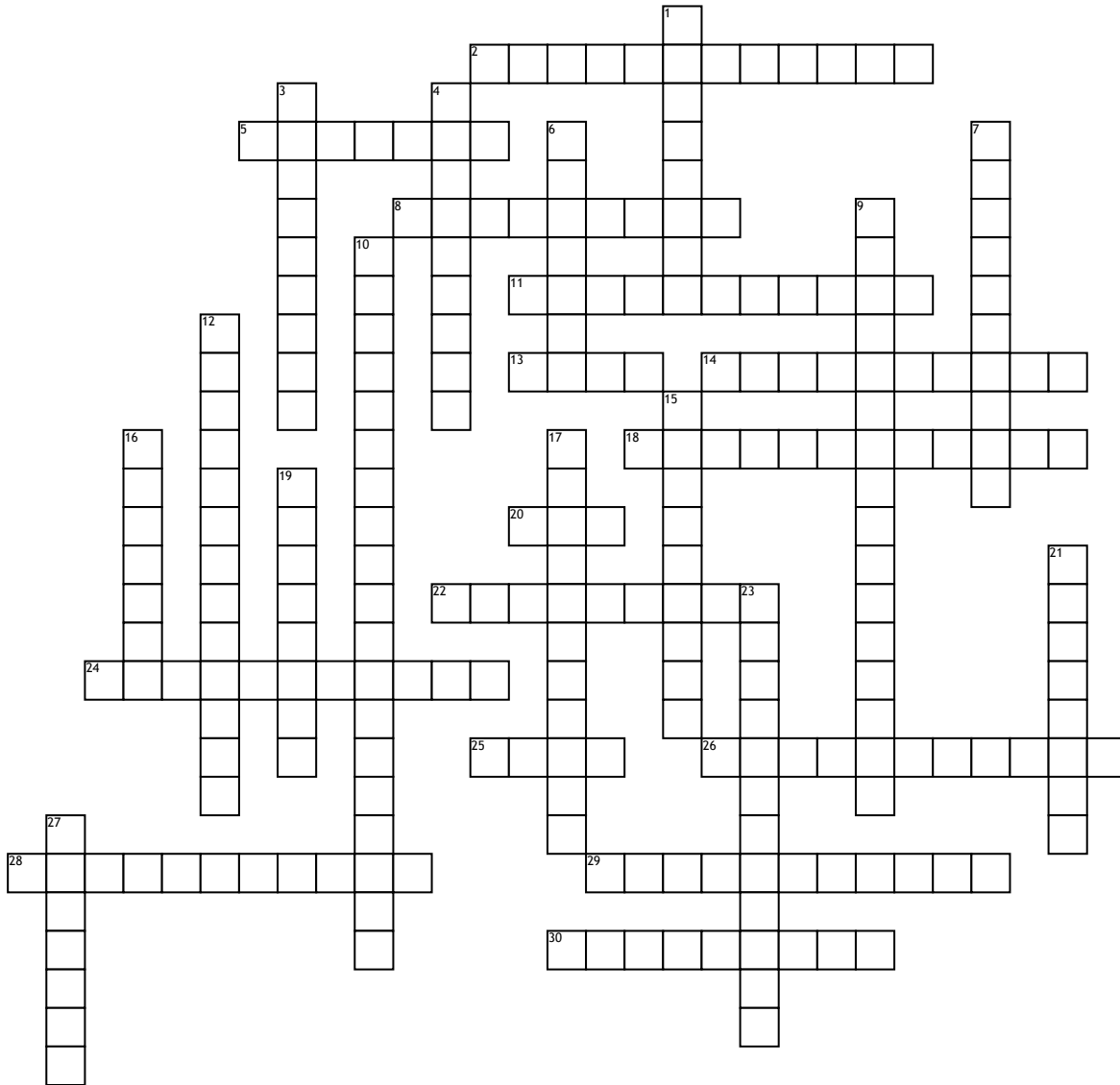


# LGBTQ crossword

1. (especially of a separated or unmarried couple) share the duties of parenting (a child).
3. is a non-binary gender defined as being more than one gender
4. metaphor for LGBT people's self-disclosure of their sexual orientation or of their gender identity.
6. without sexual feelings or associations.
7. dislike of or prejudice against homosexual people.

9. External appearance of one's gender identity, usually expressed through behavior, clothing, haircut or voice
10. A broad term referring to people who do not behave in a way that conforms to the traditional expectations of their gender
12. a person's perception of having a particular gender, which may or may not correspond with their birth sex.
15. is a term historically used by gay men who dress in the clothing usually associated with women for the purpose of entertainment or personal fulfillment.
16. A domestic partnership is an interpersonal relationship between two individuals who live together and share a common domestic life but are not married
17. The fear and hatred of, or discomfort with, transgender people.
19. term used to refer to individuals who identify as a heterosexual, meaning having a sexual, emotional, physical and relational attraction to individuals of the "opposite" gender/sex.
