3. This cone shaped lake reaches depths of up to 6 metres.

4. A medieval castle , now a very popular luxury hotel occupies an estate on this lake's north-eastern shore.

6. This 90 acre lake is situated just outside the village of Eslin.

8. This lakes name is Irish for "Lake of the white cow"

9. This small ,shallow lake which means "the dead lake" is connected to Lough Scur by a half-mile channel.

10. This lake is located on the R201, the Carrick-on-Shannon to Mohill Road

11. This lake is on the river Shannon close to the lakes at 15 and 16 and to Derrycarne woods **Down**

1. This hourglass shaped lake is 7 mtrs deep in places and it is connected to Lough Scur by a 500 m stream

2. This lake is connected to Lough Scur by a 400 metre channel and is close to a village of the same name.

5. The lake's name is Irish for "Lake of the red cow."

7. This lake on the river Shannon has 2 islands called Crose's island and Inismucker.
