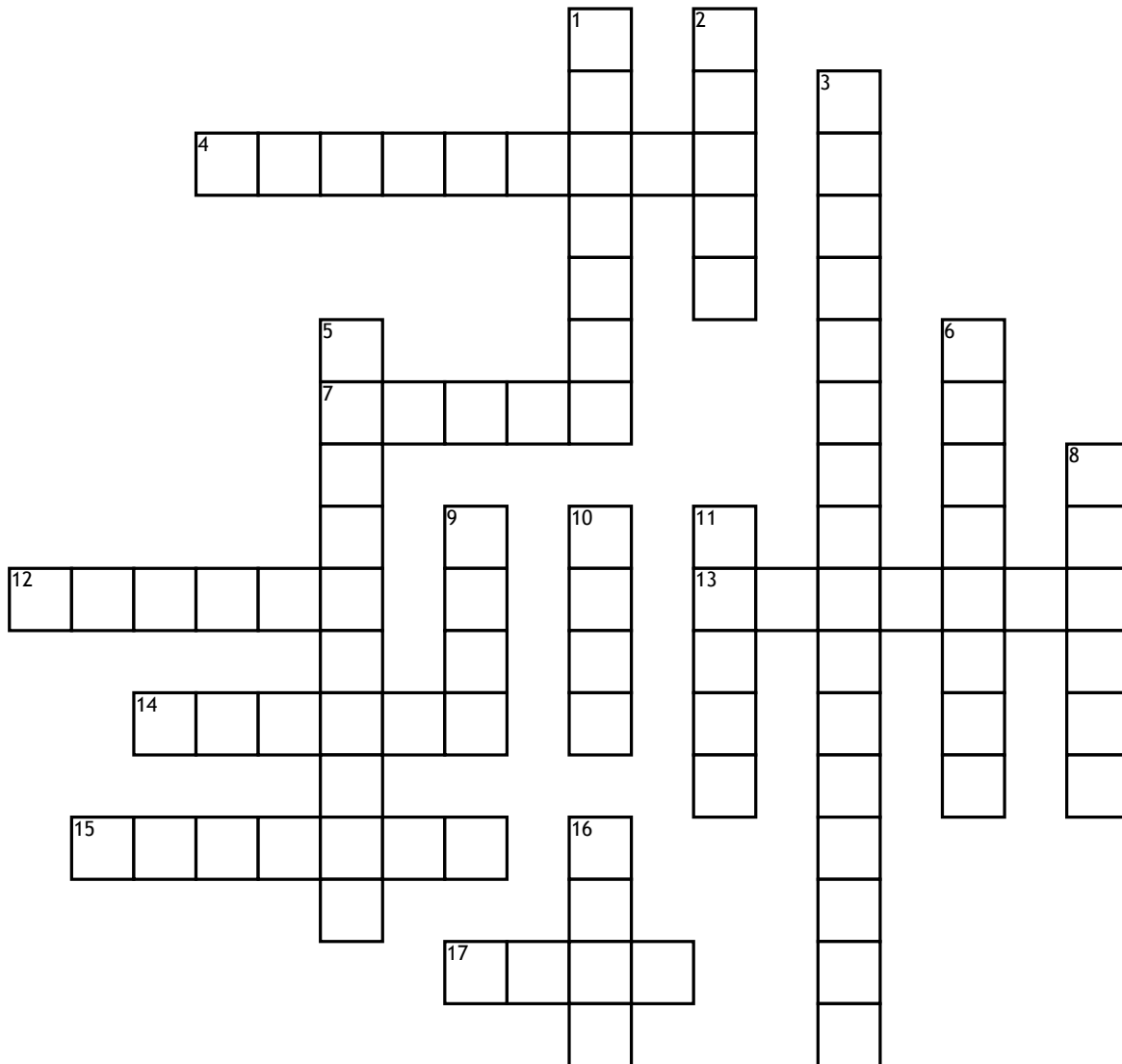

 12. A very hot area of land where few plants grow.
 13. Where the leader of a country or capital lives.
 14. An area of land that has water on all four sides.
 15. A high area of land with steep sides that is flat on top.

17. A body of water that is connected to the ocean and almost completely surrounded by land.

1. The invisible line splitting the globe into its northern and southern halves.
 2. A large area of flat, grassy land.
 3. A long body of water that lies West of Wisconsin.
 5. A group of five lakes found by Wisconsin and Michigan.
