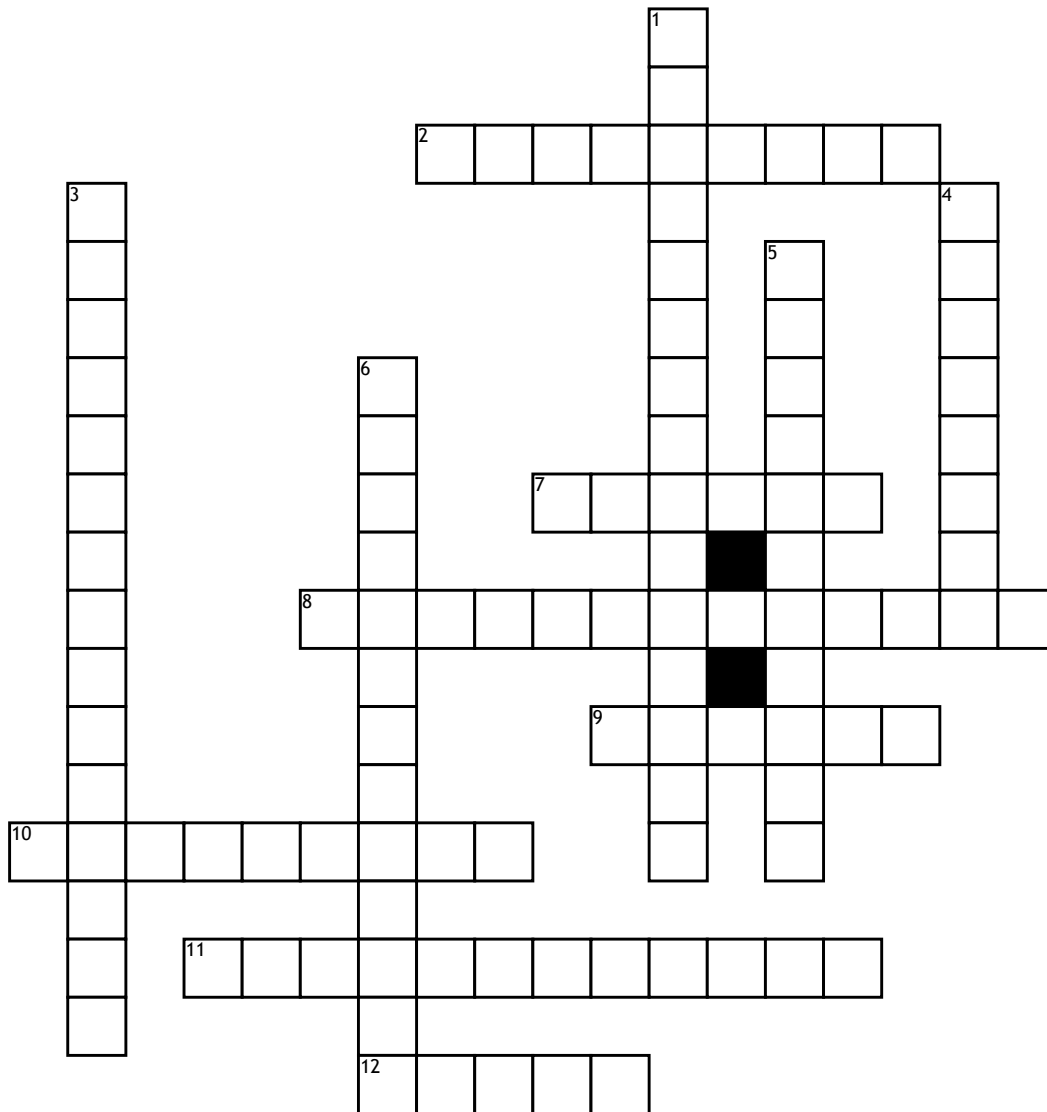


# Language Techniques Crossword
