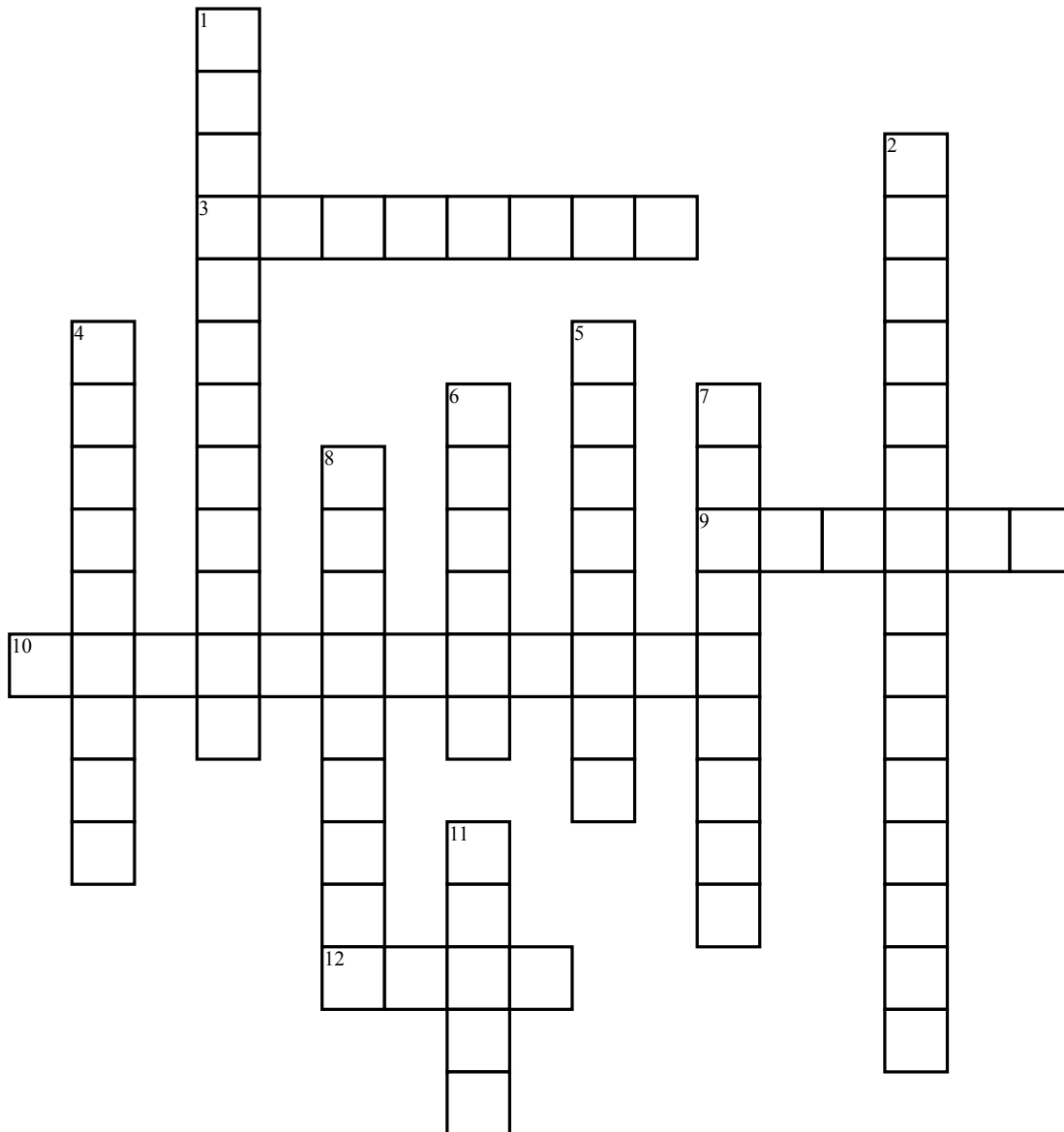

1. refers to words both derived from sounds and used to suggest sound. "Ping" and "tick, tock"
2. When something that is not human is given human-like qualities
4. when a noun which has meaning in itself is used to represent something entirely different.
5. A short sometimes vulgar, humorous poem consisting of five anapestic lines.
6. A poem that tells a story similar to a folk tale or legend which often has a repeated refrain.
7. refers to word phrases with similar sounds repeated in the words, such as the "ee" sound in "easy to please."
8. Exaggerating, often in a humorous way, to make a particular point .
11. A Japanese poem composed of three unrhymed lines of five, seven, and five morae, usually containing a season word.
