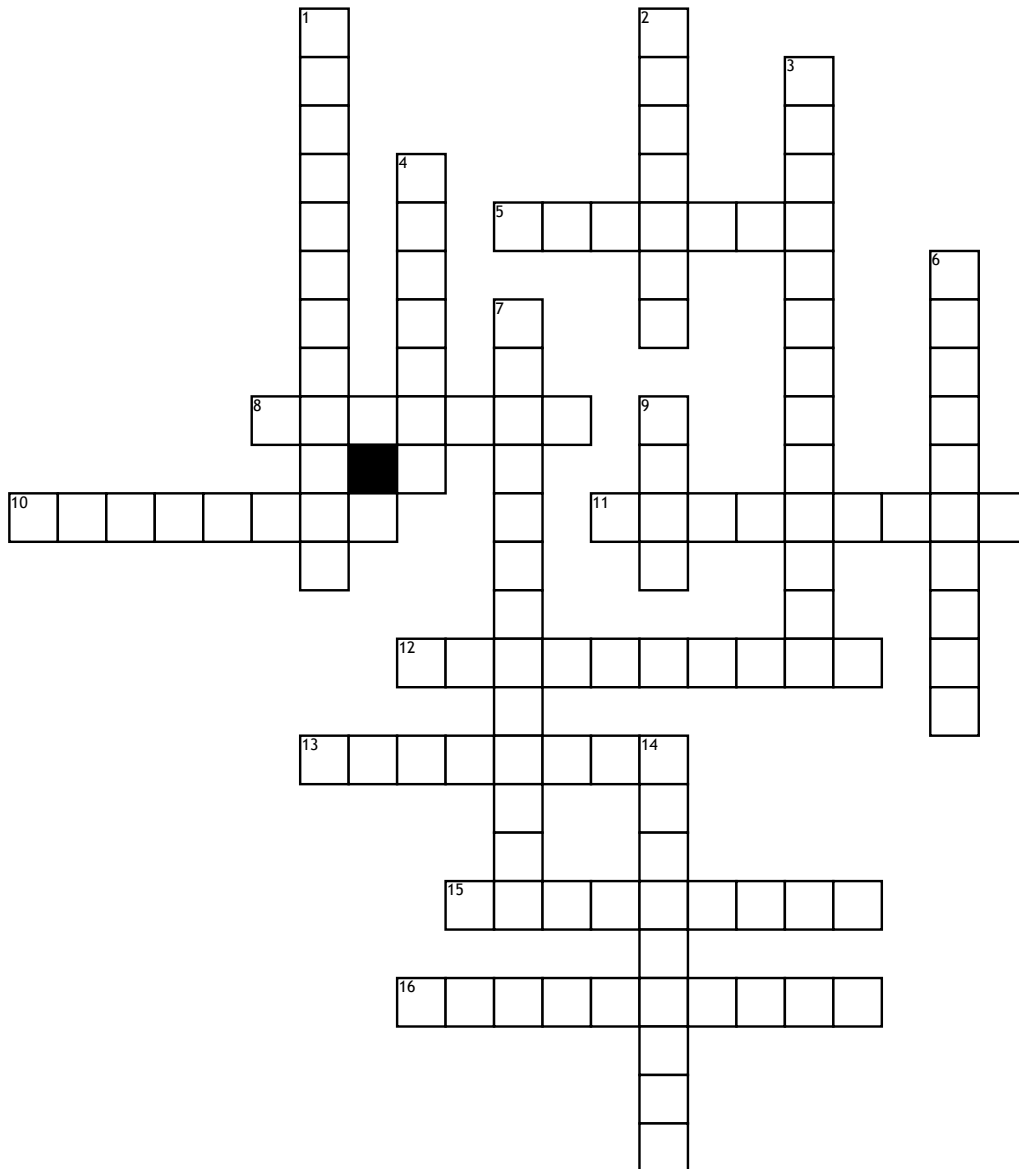

2. Defined as the one that make an offer to another

4. Words and conduct of the parties indicate they intended an agreement

6. Withdrawal of an offer by the offeror

7. Parties intended a valid contract but the Court declares that some rule of law prevents its enforcement

9. Neither party can legally enforce the contract

14. Binding agreement, but one or more parties has not yet fulfilled its obligations
