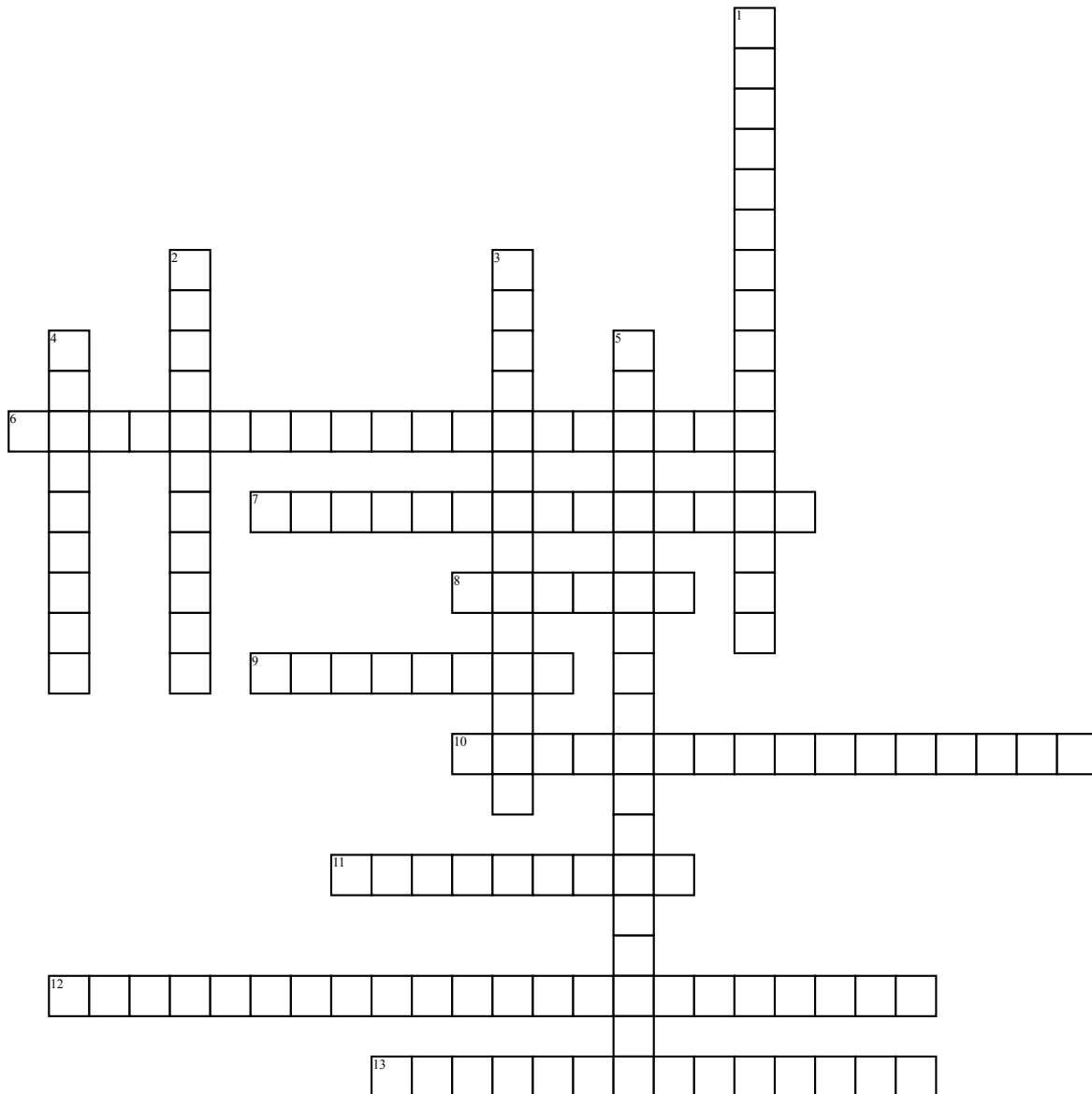


Lesson 11 Vocabulary

- 6. An ongoing part of instruction designed to provide feedback about students' learning
- 7. Students' assessment of their own learning
- 8. A scoring tool that lists the criteria for judging a particular type of work
- 9. a characteristic of assessments that actually measures the learning objectives
- 10. Making judgments about how well a course meets its goals and identifying suggestions for improvement

- 11. A simple list of items to be noted, checked, or remembered when evaluating learning
- 12. Range from written papers and multimedia presentations to real-life tasks and student portfolios
- 13. Helps new teachers assess and improve their skills, solve problems, and become comfortable in their new positions

- 1. A collection of a students' work selected to show growth over time, highlight skills and achievements, or to show how well the students meet standards

- 2. A characteristic of assessments that measures learning consistently and fairly, even with different groups or under different circumstances
- 3. Students' assessment of each others learning
- 4. Lists the characters or factors to use when evaluating learning
- 5. An evaluation of students' learning after instruction has taken place
