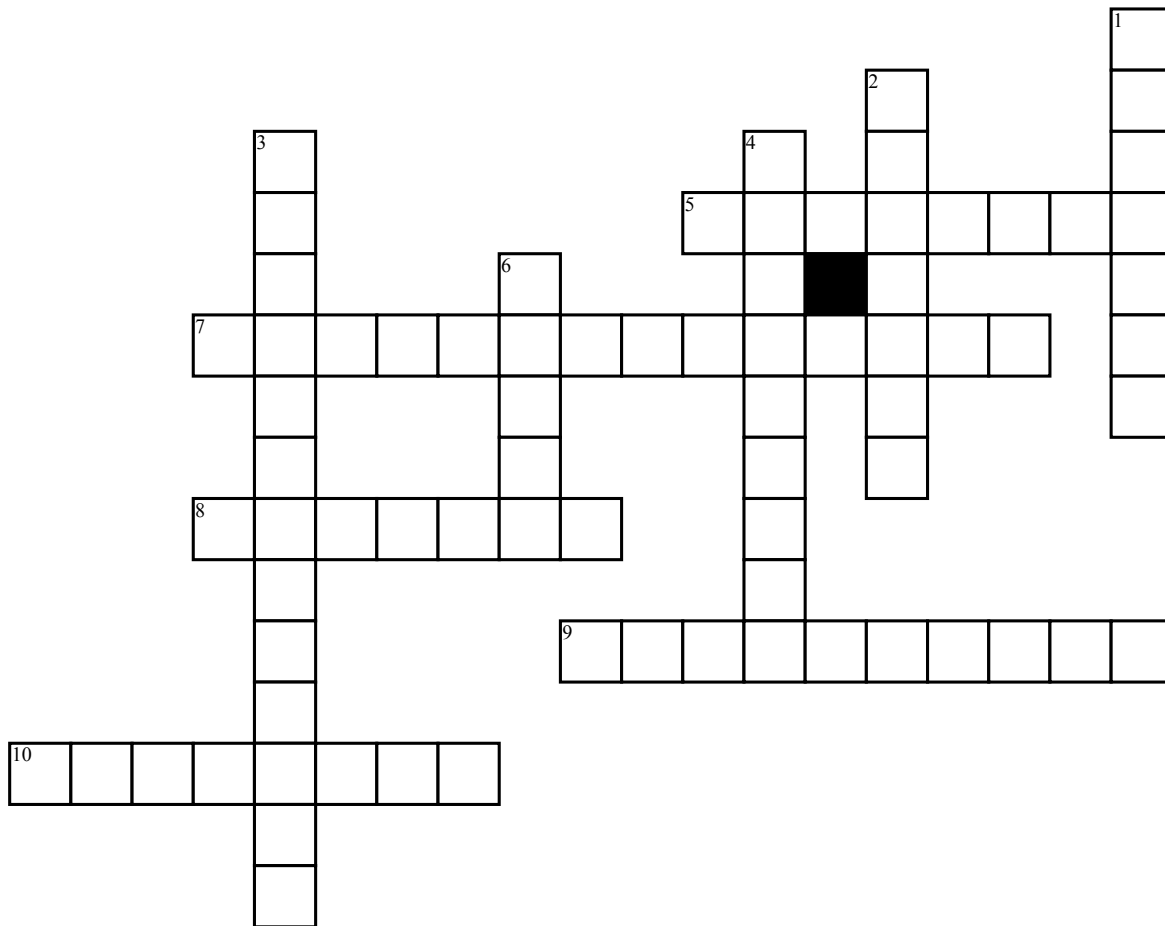

5. Text entries that are inserted automatically when you type a specific set of characters
7. Built-in reusable content such as text, graphics, and objects that can be easily managed and inserted in a document for a quick format
8. A symbol that enables most of the languages in the world to be symbolized with a special character identification
9. Built-in text that display lightly behind the document's main text conveying the sensitivity of the document
10. A feature that allows a user to set a specific font and font size

1. An invisible, formatted box in which you can insert and position text and/or graphic objects
2. A large initial letter that drops down two or more lines at the beginning of a paragraph to indicate that a new block of information is beginning and to give interest to newsletters or magazine articles
3. A set of predefined formatting options that include theme colors, fonts, and effects
4. A sentence or other text displayed within a box on the page for emphasis and for ease of movement
6. A placeholder where Word inserts content in a document .
