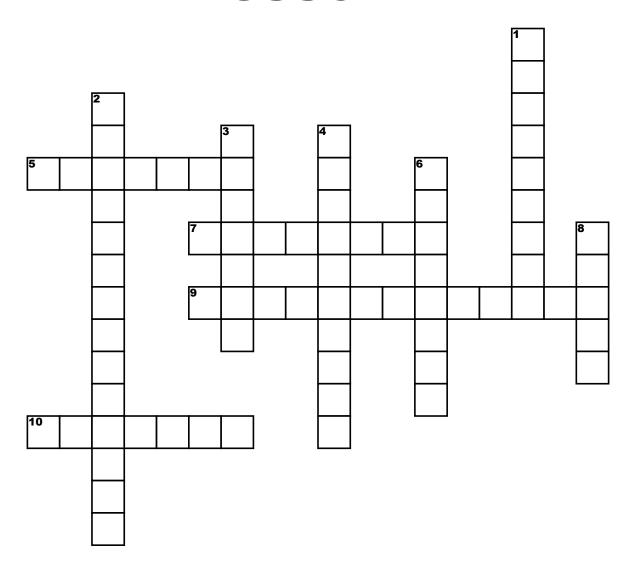

1. A sentence or other text displayed within a box on the page for emphasis and for ease of movement; often used along with drop caps in newsletters, advertisements, and magazines.

- 2. Built-in reusable content such as text, graphics, and objects that can be easily managed and inserted in a document for a quick format.
- 3. An invisible, formatted box in which you can insert and position text and/or graphic objects
- **4.** Built-in text that display lightly behind the document's main text conveying the sensitivity of the document, such as, confi dential, draft, or urgent
- **6.** Text entries that are inserted automatically when you type a specifi c set of characters
- 8. A placeholder where Word inserts content in a document. Word automatically uses fi elds when specifi c commands are activated, such as those for inserting dates, page numbers, and a table of contents.
