

- **3.** A large initial letter that drops down two or more lines at the beginning of a paragraph to indicate that a new block of information is beginning and to give interest to newsletters or magazine articles.
- **5.** A sentence or other text displayed within a box on the page for emphasis and for ease of movement; often used along with drop caps in newsletters, advertisements, and magazines.
- **6.** A symbol that enables most of the languages in the world to be symbolized with a special character identification.
- **8.** A feature that allows a user to set a specific font and font size.

- **9.** An invisible, formatted box in which you can insert and position text and/or graphic objects.
- **10.** Built-in text that display lightly behind the document's main text conveying the sensitivity of the document.
