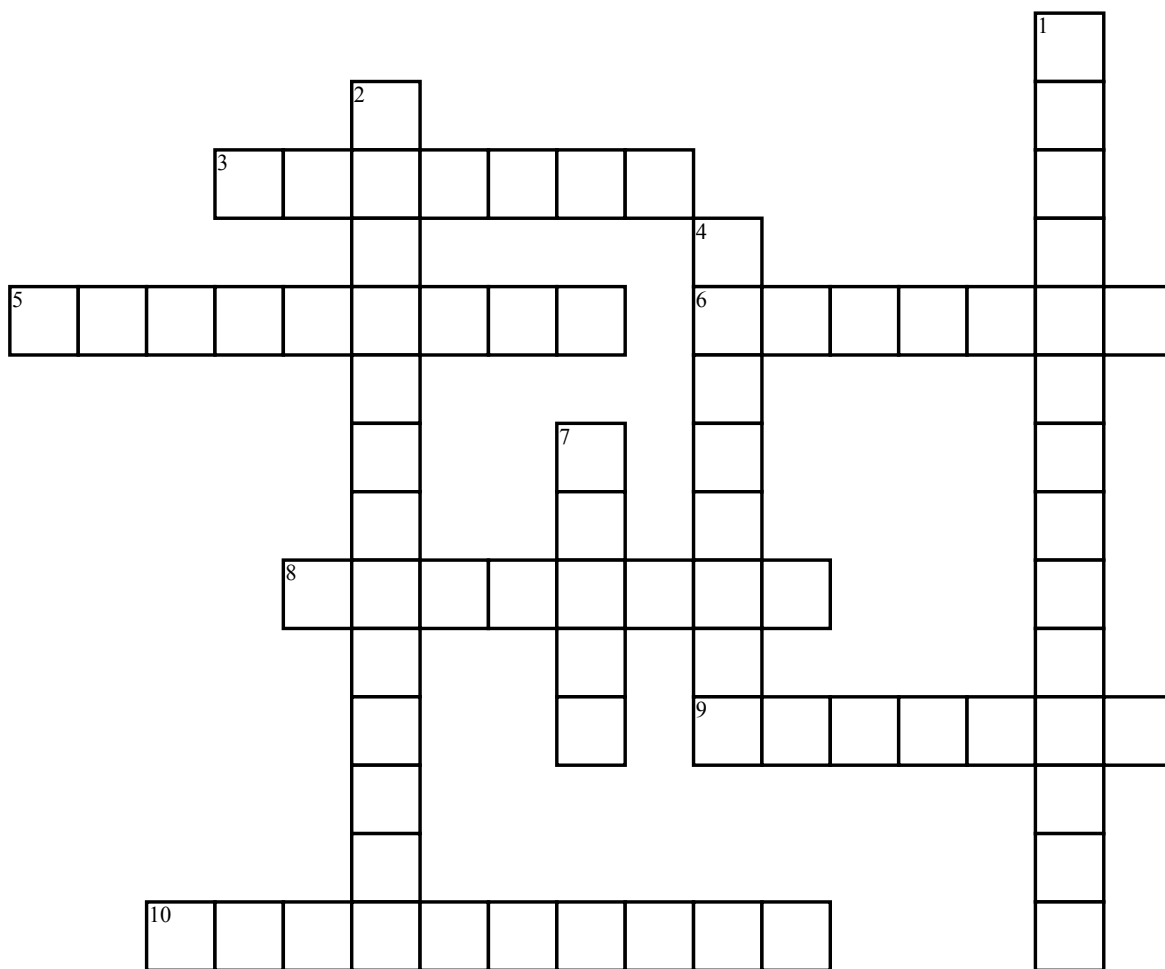

3. A large initial letter that drops down two or more lines at the beginning of a paragraph to indicate that a new block of information is beginning and to give interest to newsletters or magazine articles.

5. A sentence or other text displayed within a box on the page for emphasis and for ease of movement; often used along with drop caps in newsletters, advertisements, and magazines.

6. A symbol that enables most of the languages in the world to be symbolized with a special character identification.

8. A feature that allows a user to set a specific font and font size.

9. An invisible, formatted box in which you can insert and position text and/or graphic objects.

10. Built-in text that display lightly behind the document's main text conveying the sensitivity of the document.

1. Built-in reusable content such as text, graphics, and objects that can be easily managed and inserted in a document for a quick format.

2. A set of predefined formatting options that includes theme colors, fonts, and effects.

4. Text entries that are inserted automatically when you type a specific set of characters.

7. A placeholder where Word inserts content in a document.
