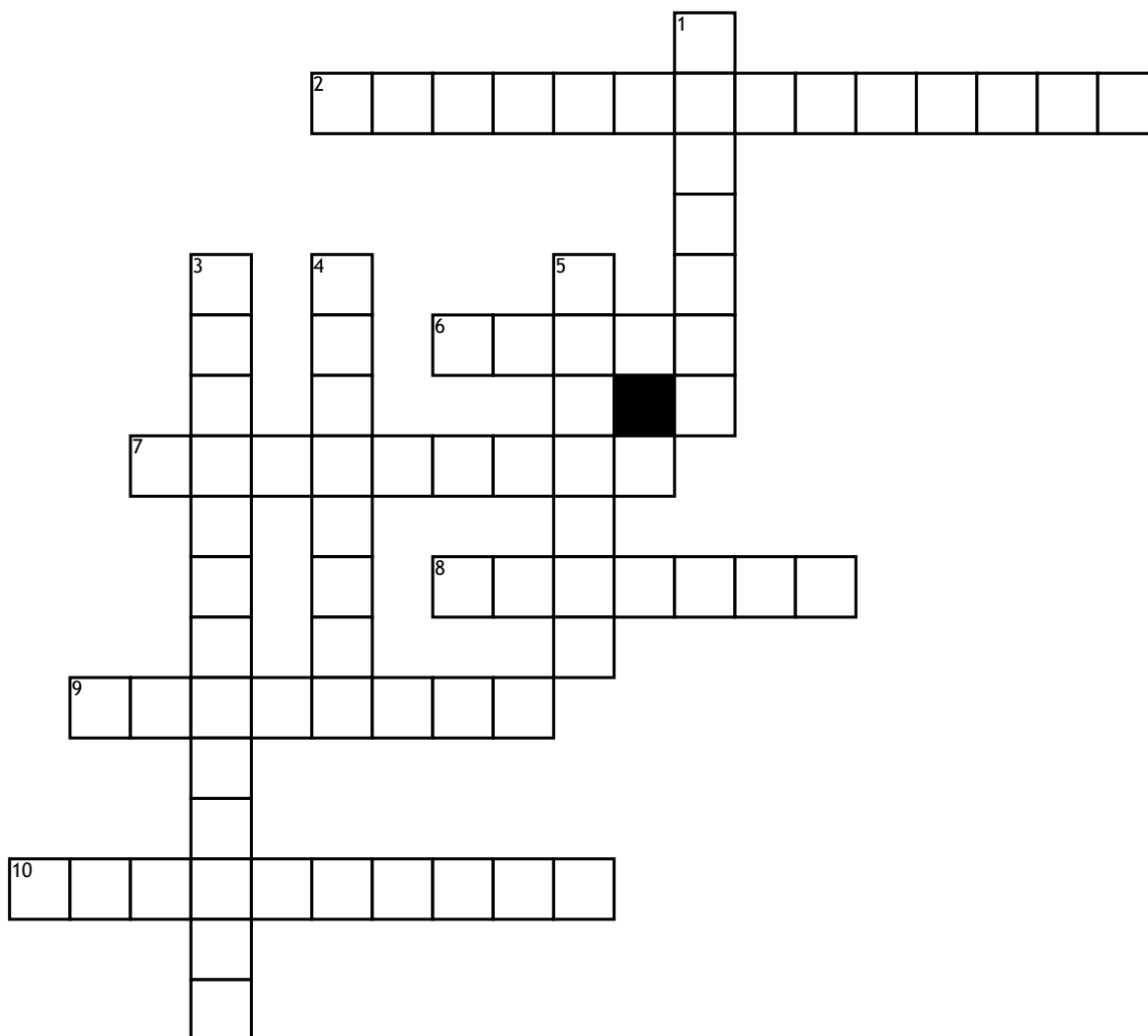

2. Built-in reusable content such as text, graphics, and objects that can be easily managed.
6. A placeholder where Word inserts content in a document.
7. A sentence or other text displayed within a box on the page for emphasis and for ease of movement.
8. The first letter of a paragraph that's of a much bigger size than the rest that follow.
9. Text entries that are inserted automatically when you type a specific set of characters.

10. Built-in text that display lightly behind the document's main text conveying the sensitivity of the document.

1. A symbol that enables most of the languages in the world to be symbolized with a special character identification.
