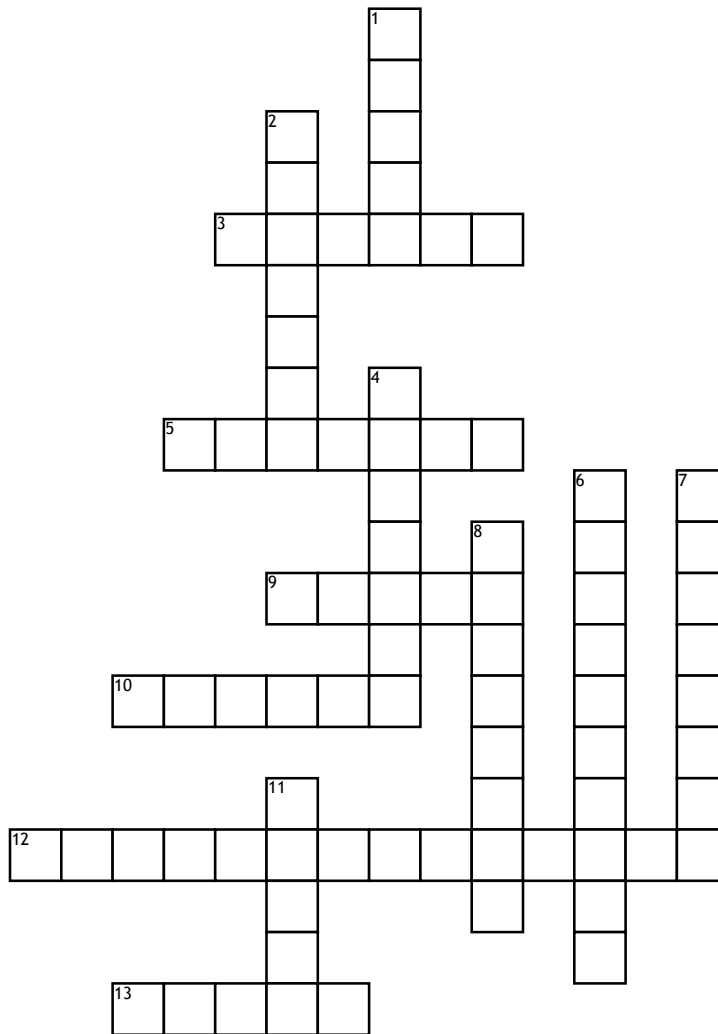


Levels of classification and kingdoms
