

- **2.** Aquatic Organisms that drift with the currents or have limited swimming abilites.
- **3.** A nutritional organization of organisms, pertaining to the food chain
- **7.** The extreme depths of this zone are found mostly in deep-water trenches and canyons
- **8.** This zone is the range of depths between the highest and lowest extent of the tides.
- **9.** Organisms that break down living or dead material into chemicals that can be recycled as nutrients

- **4.** Organisms that convert light energy into chemical energy and appear at the base of the trophic pyramid
- **5.** This type of plankton is animal plankton ranging from microscopic sea stars to huge jellyfish
- **6.** This group of plankton contains chlorophyll and is divided into diatoms, dinoflagellates and some species of algae like blue-green algae
