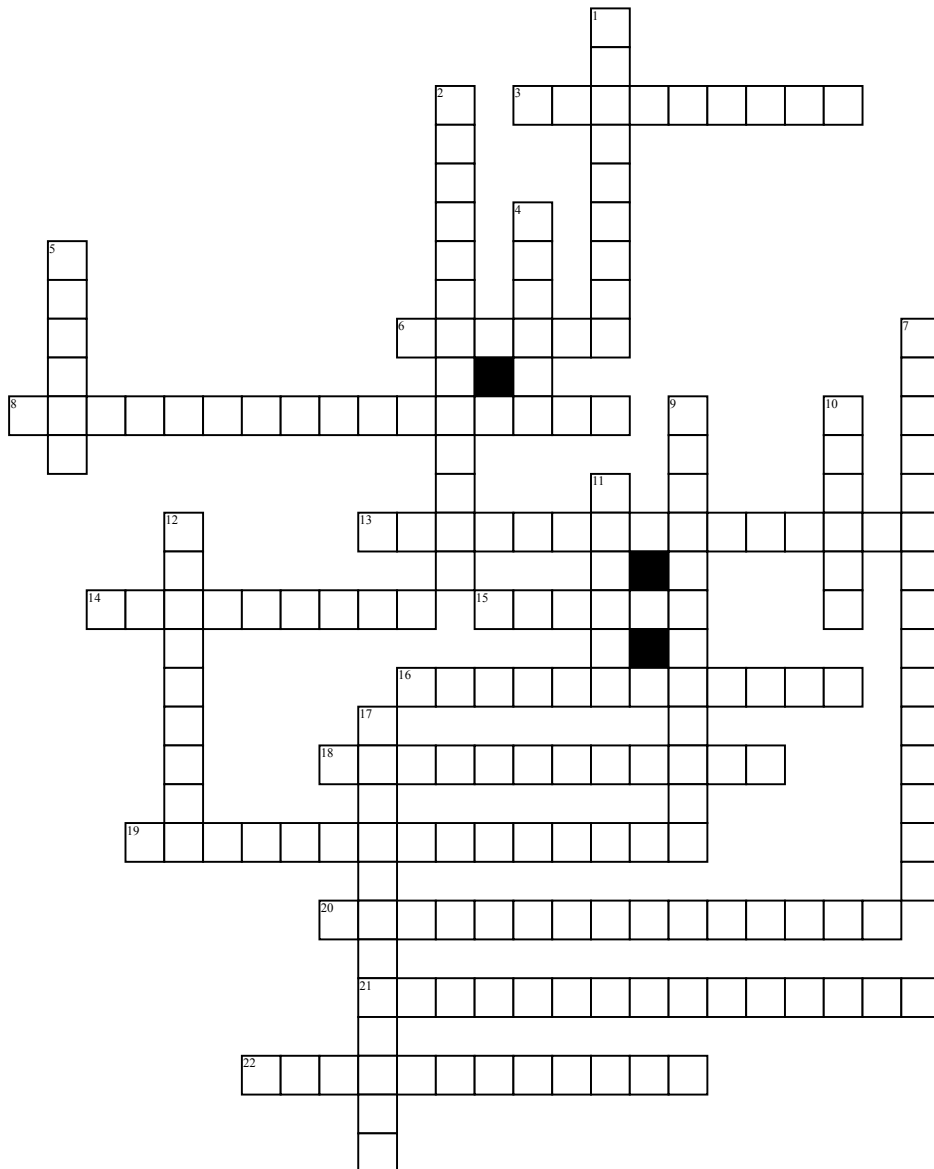


Life On The Great Northern Peninsula
