
Lincoln, Secession, and War

4. The most important of the four forts that still remained in Union hands.

8. Republican nominee and eventual winner of the election, who thought that slavery shouldn't be allowed in the territories. Led the North in the Civil War.

9. Mississippi senator who convinced Congress to adopt resolutions restricting federal control over slavery in the territories

10. The group of states that left the Union in order to protect slavery.

<u>Down</u>

1. The northern Democrat nominee who wanted to allow popular sovereignty in the territories on the basis of slavery.

 The southern Democrat nominee who wanted to protect slavery and expand to the territories.
A final agreement and attempt made to try to stop the civil war that would have allowed for slavery in the western territories, anywhere below the Missouri Compromise.

5. The group of states united under one country and government in America.

6. The practice of having ownership of another person.

7. To withdraw formally from membership of a federal union, an alliance, or a political or religious organization.
