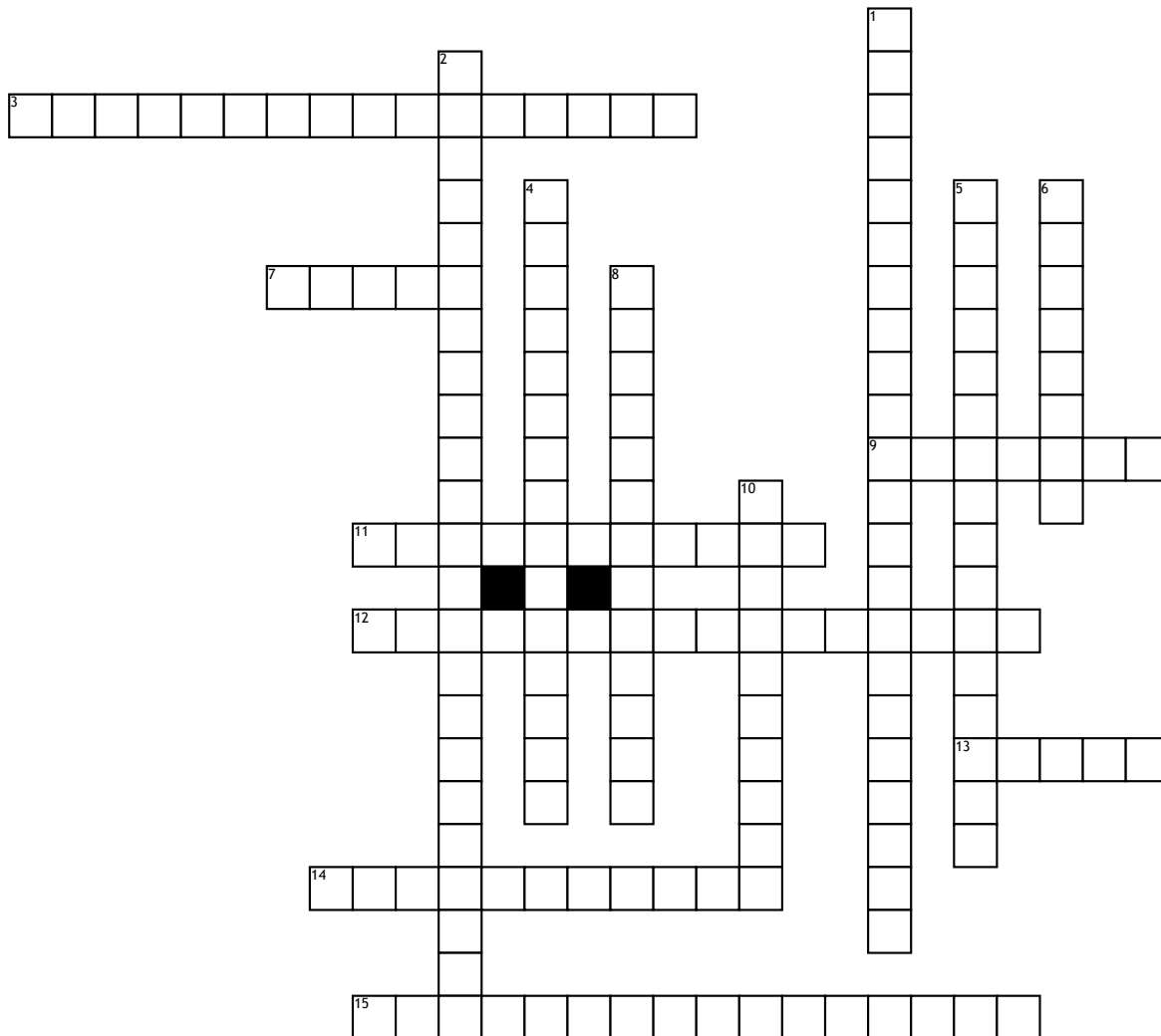


# Literary Elements
