

- 1. lymph nodes in the groin
- **2.** lymphocytes that differentiate into plasma cells
- **3.** patches of lymphatic tissue located at the entrance of the pharynx
- **5.** soft, loosely organized, highly vascular material, seperated from osseous tissue by the endosteum of the bone
- 8. body's largest lymphatic organ

- **9.** organ on the endocrine and lymphatic, and immune systems, houses developing lymphocytes and secretes hormones
- 11. branched, stationary APC's that contribute to the connective tissue framework of the lymphatic organs
- 13. tissue deep to the cortex of certain two layered organs (lymph nodes, adrenal glands, hairs, kidneys)
- **15.** The ability to ward off specific infection or disease
- **18.** the outer layer of some organs (adrenal glands, kidneys, cerebrum, lymph nodes, ovaries, and hairs)
