
Lymphatic System

2. Is a much larger tube, drains the lymph from the rest of the body

6. located on each side of the soft palate

9. called glands, are located all over the body usually in groups or clusters. Small round or oval masses ranging in size from a pinhead to an almond 10. masses of lymphatic tissue that filter interstitial fluid 11. pick up digested fats or lipids **12.** Is a thin watery fluid composed of intercellular or interstitial fluid,

13. A mass of lymph tissue located in the center of the upper chest. It wastes away after puberty

14. made up of two more or less distinct groups of which one is disposed along the inguinal ligament <u>Down</u>

1. pick up lymph at tissues throughout the body.

3. drain lymph vessels from the lateral quadrants of the breast

4. forms when plasma diffuses into tissue spaces
5. located throughout the body in almost all of the tissues that have blood vessels
7. An organ located beneath the left of the diaphragm and in back of the upper part of the stomach

8. Or pharyngeal tonsils; located in the nasopharynx
