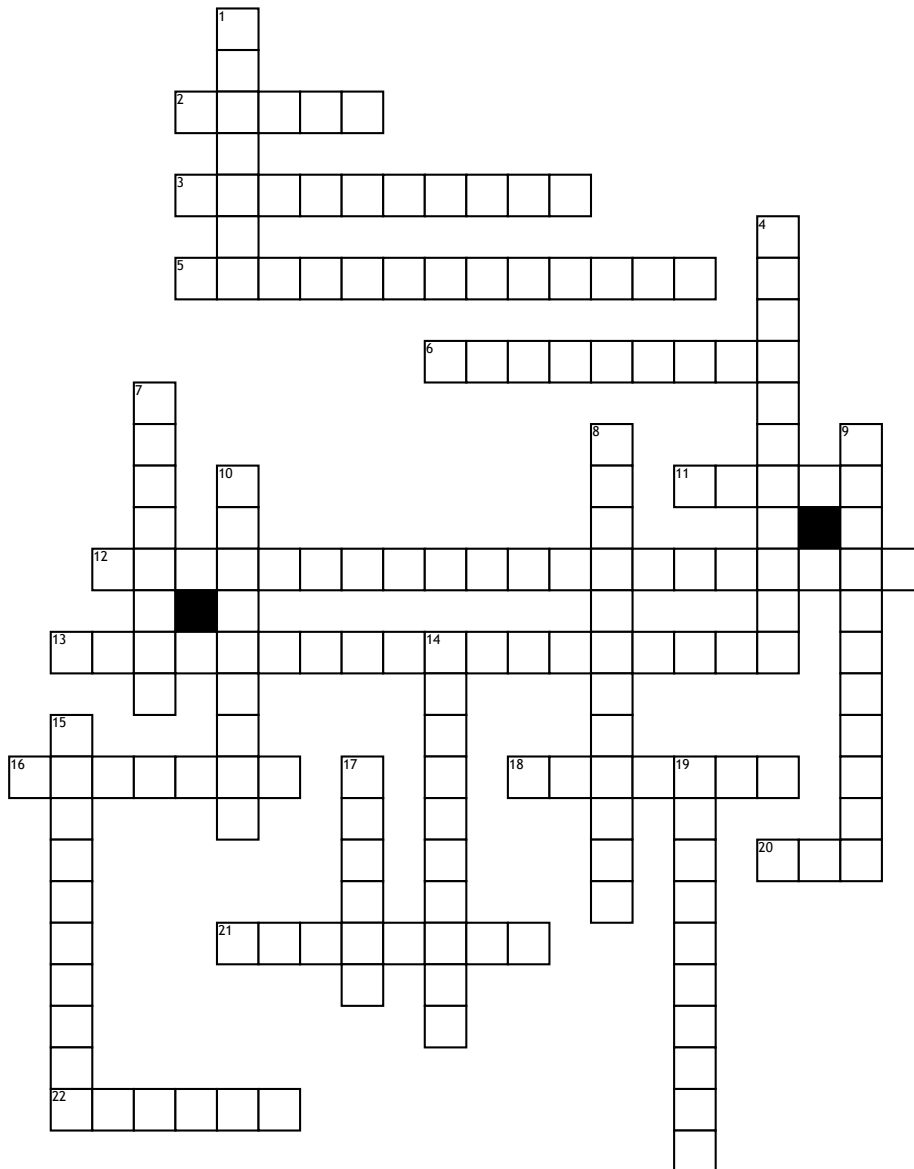


Lymphatic Vocabulary

 5. resemble tonsils

18. macrophages are located here

20. mixture of dead or dying neutrophils and pathogens and broken down tissue
 21. tube-like offshoot of the first part of the large intestine
 22. organ that filters blood

1. artificially acquired bacterial or viral infection
 4. have memory
