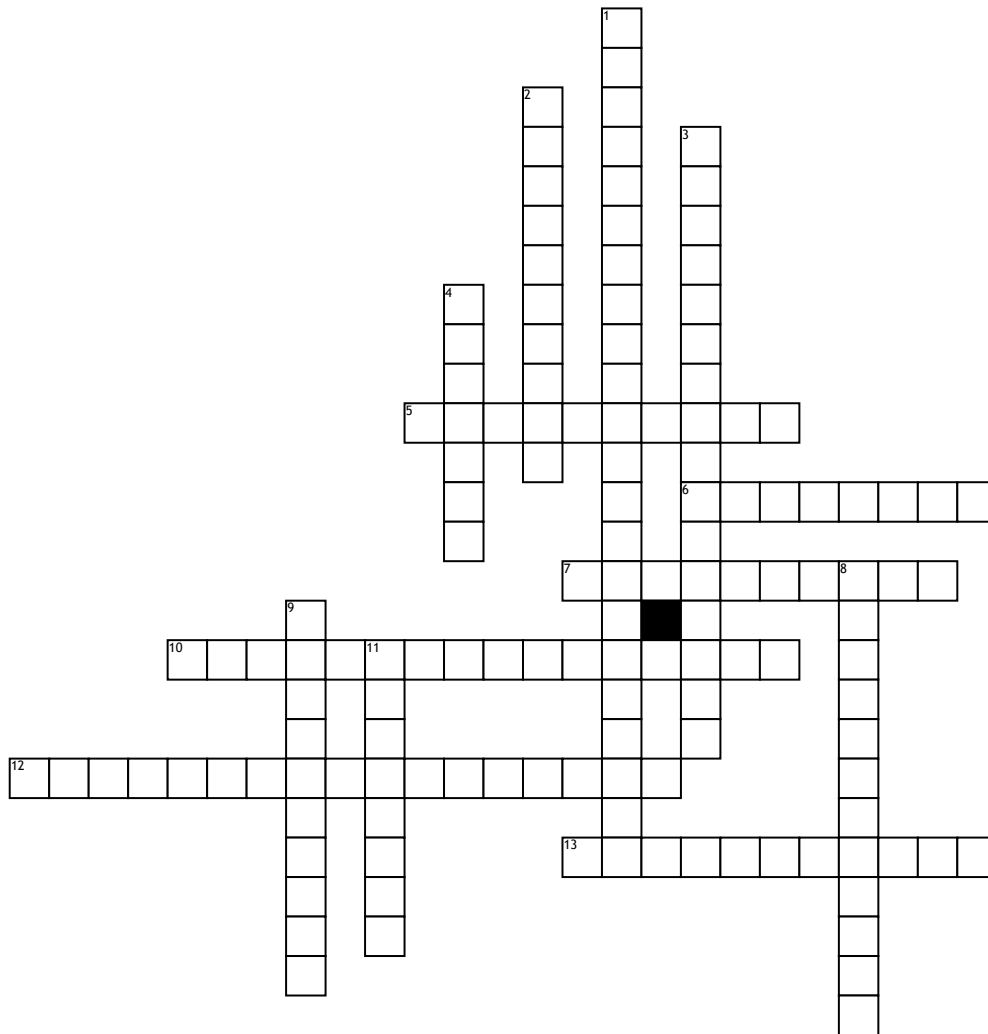


# Lymphatic system, Sienna reynolds
