
## MEDSCI201 Lab 2 Medial & Lateral Surface of the Knee



## **Across**

- **5.** An extension of the synovial joint space
- **6.** Inserts on the anterior side of the lateral femoral condyle of bovine knee & extends inferiorly
- **7.** Insertion of the bicep femoris muscle in the human knee
- **8.** Insertion of the bicep femoris muscle in the bovine knee
- **9.** Provides strength and is mostly found on the outside of the meniscus

- **10.** Originates from the lateral side of the lateral femoral condyle and inserts on the medial side of the tibia
- 11. Found between the femur and tibia

## **Down**

- 1. Action that occurs as a result of the popliteus muscle on the femur during muscle contraction
- 2. Main knee extensors of the knee
- **3.** Smaller ligament found near the lateral collateral ligament that helps with stability of the patella during movement of the knee
- **4.** Ligament that the medial meniscus is attached to in humans but not in the bovine knee
