

- **2.** A B A (3 sections with the first and last the same)
- **8.** Many melody lines/pitches but only ONE rhythm played together
- **9.** several repetitions of a melodic phrase in different pitches moving up or down by step
- **10.** Many melody lines/tunes, many rhythms played by many people

- **11.** a musical phrase (tune or rhythm) repeated over and over during a composition
- **12.** a key whose harmony is based on the major scale which sounds happy

## **Down**

- 1. copying the tune or melody of another instrument or vocal part
- 3. a key based on the minor scale which sounds sad or depressing

- **4.** the chordal progression of dominant to tonic i.e. V-I (a fullstop cadence)
- 5. getting louder
- **6.** A single melody line/tune played by many people
- 7. Getting quieter
