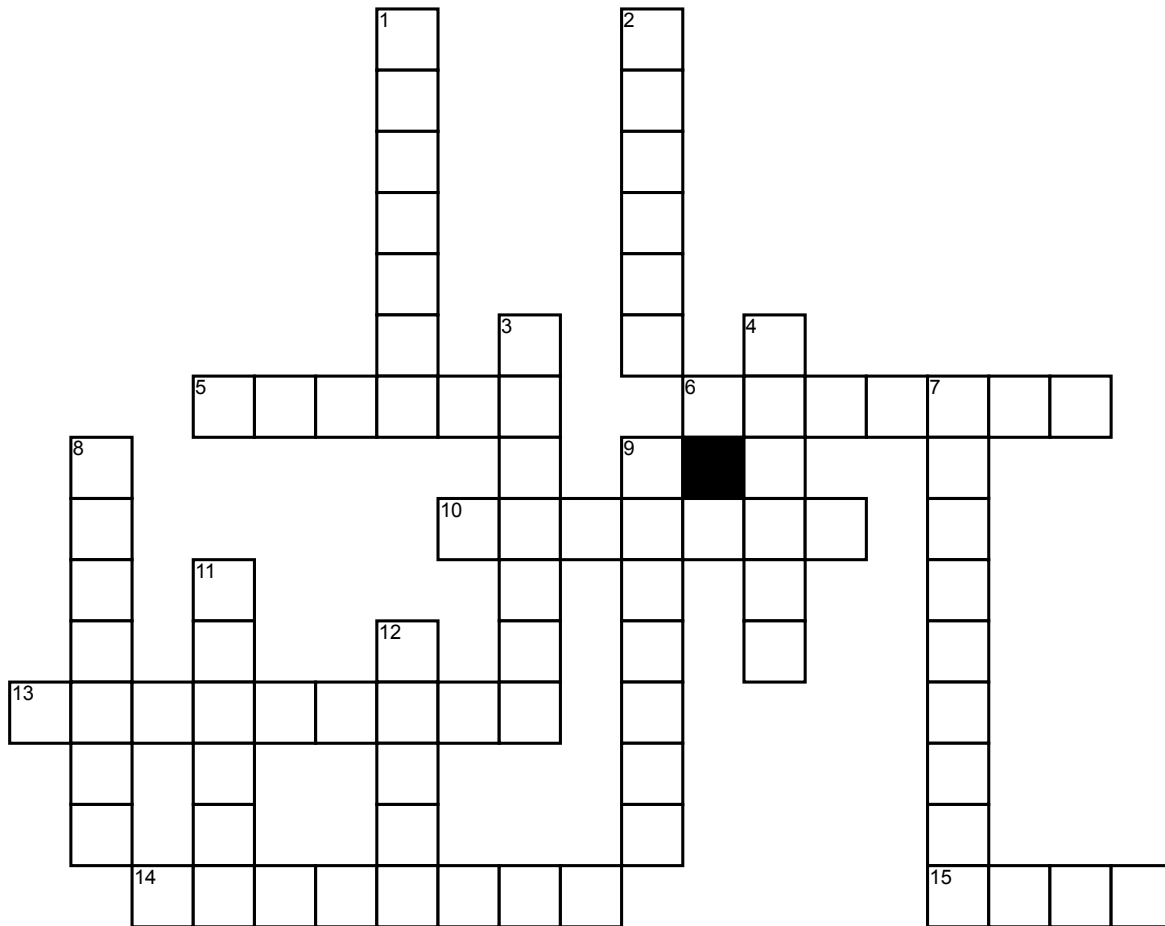


Macbeth crossword
