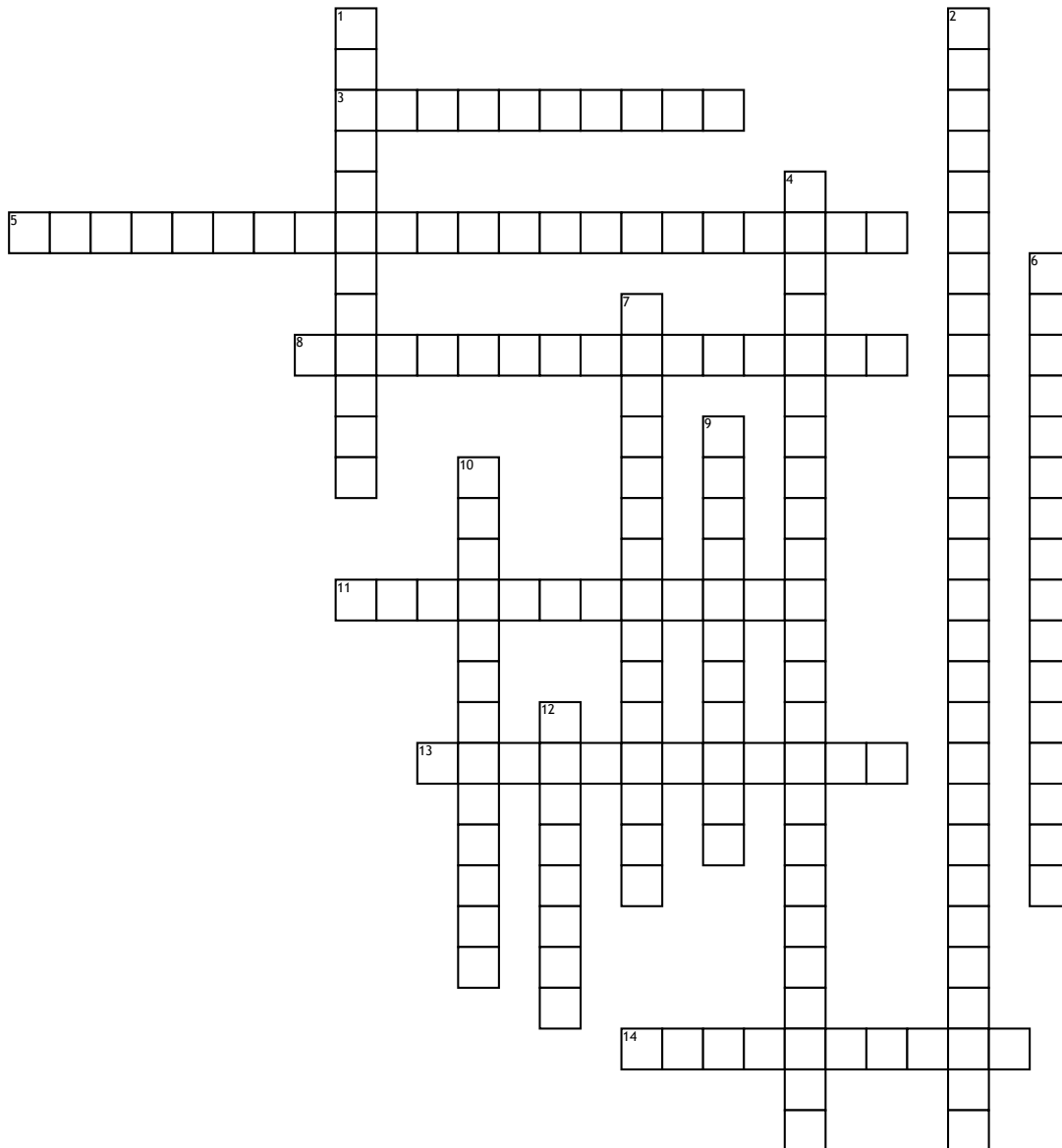


Male and Female reproductive organs.

3. a mucous plug is formed by which region of the cervix
