
Map terminology

- **4.** Half of Earth which is east of the prime meridian
- 7. a map of the world made in the shape of a ball.
- **9.** A map that focuses on the geography of the area and will often have shaded relief to show the mountains and valleys.
- **10.** The angular distance of a place north or south of the Earth's equator.
- 11. An imaginary line drawn around the Earth equally distant from both poles, dividing the earth into northern and southern hemispheres.

- **12.** Is the half of Earth that is north of the Equator.
- **13.** Half of the Earth which is west of the equator
- **14.** The Earth's zero of longitude, which by convention passes through Greenwich, England.

- 1. Is the half of the Earth south of the equator
- **2.** The four intermediate compass directions located halfway between each pair of cardinal directions.
- 3. A map that focuses on boundaries between entities, like countries, states or counties.

- **5.** a half of the earth, usually as divided into northern and southern halves by the equator, or into western and eastern halves by an imaginary line passing through the poles.
- 6. The angular distance of a place east or west of the meridian at Greenwich, England.
- **8.** The height of an object or point in relation to sea level or ground level.
