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| 1. Fast acting bronchodialator | A. Albuterol |
| 2. Shortness of breath. Difficult or labored breathing. | B. Pulse Oximetry |
| 3. Plastic tubing used to supply oxygen through the nose. | C. Exacerbations |
| 4. Flare-ups of Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease in which symptoms get worse. | D. Sputum |
| 5. Medicines that are anti-inflammatory | E. Nebulizer |
| 6. Rapid breathing often caused by being nervous or panicked. | F. Dyspnea |
| 7. Too little oxygen in the body. | G. Inhaler |
| 8. A portable device to take inhaled medicine in a couple of breaths. | H. Corticosteroids |
| 9. A machine that turns medication into a mist for inhalation. | I. Spirometry |
| 10. A machine used for oxygen therapy. It has a pump that takes oxygen from the air, and moves it through a long narrow tube into the nose. | J. Cannula |
| 11. This test measures how much oxygen is in your blood. | K. Hyperventilation |
| 12. This is a part of a Pulmonary Function Test. It measures the amount of air able to be breathed out forcefully. It is used to help diagnose lung diseases. | L. Oxygen Concentrator |
| 13. Mucus, usually loose in the lungs. It may be coughed up. | M. Hypoxia |
