

- **3.** extremities (hands and feet), top, extreme point
- 5. stimulates the sympathetic nervous system, it makes the heart beat faster and the liver release glucose; a vasoconstrictor to treat heart dysrhythmias and asthma attacks. Also known as adrenaline
- 8. excessive hunger
- **12.** stimulates uterine contractions during childbirth
- **13.** an autoimmune disorder that causes hyperthyroidism
- **14.** a normal metabolic process. When the body does not have enough glucose for energy, it burns stored fats instead
- **16.** secreted by the pancreas, increases blood sugar by stimulating the break down of glycogen to glucose

- **18.** stimulates the maturation of lymphocytes into T cells
- **19.** abnormal protrusion of the eyeball out of the orbit
- 20. excessive thirst

- 1. abnormal enlargement of the extremeties caused by excessive secretion of growth hormone after puberty
- 2. both a hormone and neurohormone; stimulates the sypathetic nervous system, raises blood pressure, strengthens the heartbeat, and stimulates muscle contractions

- **6.** works with the parathyroid hormone to regulate calcium levels in the blood and tissues

- **10.** hormone produced by the thryoid gland that increases metabolism and regulates growth
